COLLECTION FOR THE CHURCH IN CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE




Special Collection This Weekend—March 14-15, 2026

Pope Leo XIV Prayer for Disarmament and Peace

Lord of Life, you shaped every human being in your image and likeness.

We believe you created us for communion, not for war, for fraternity, not for destruction.

You who greeted your disciples saying, "Peace be with you," grant us the gift of your peace and the strength to make it a reality in history.

Today we lift up our prayer for peace in the world, asking that nations renounce weapons and choose the path of dialogue and diplomacy.

Disarm our hearts of hatred, resentment, and indifference, so we may become instruments of reconciliation.

Help us understand that true security does not come from control fueled by fear, but from trust, justice, and solidarity among peoples.

Lord, enlighten the leaders of the nations, so they may have the courage to abandon projects of death, halt the arms race, and place the lives of the most vulnerable at the center.

May the nuclear threat never again dictate the future of humanity.

Holy Spirit, make us faithful and creative builders of daily peace: in our hearts, our families, our communities, and our cities. May every kind word, every gesture of reconciliation, and every choice for dialogue be seeds of a new world.

The Silence of the Heart: Tuning the Radio

As we approach the end of our Lenten journey, we realize that the "attainment" of God is actually a matter of **frequency**. Imagine God's presence as radio waves filling a room. The music is already there, playing constantly. If we don't hear it, it isn't because the broadcast has stopped; it's because our "receiver" is tuned to a different station—usually the station of our own busy thoughts and anxieties.

Lenten silence is the process of tuning our hearts to the Divine frequency. Contemplation has been described as "a long, loving look at the real." It is the practice of sitting in the silence until the "chatter" of the ego dies down, allowing the underlying reality of God's presence to emerge.

This week, spend five minutes in pure silence. Do not ask for anything. Do not complain. Simply breathe and acknowledge: *"I am in You, and You are in me."* (Especially true after receiving Holy Communion!)

Reflect: What "noise" in my life is currently drowning out the constant broadcast of God's love?

Ideally, children should know what healthy relationships look like in their own lives. This example is important for them to learn how to develop their own relationships. Children need to know that everyone has the right to feel safe and respected, and that violence and abuse are never okay in any relationship or interaction. Safe adults can talk about the importance of respect and kindness, and model that in their own relationships to show children how to navigate friendships, conflict, and other interactions.
