Take time this Lent for a prayerful encounter with the Psalms.

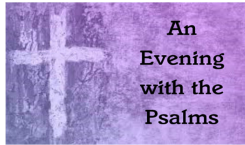
**March 25, Wednesday evening at 6:30pm** in San Roque Church.

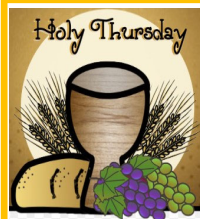

### The Mirror of the True Self: Returning to Our Original Goodness

As we draw closer to Holy Week, the tension of Lent often builds. We may feel the weight of our failures or the difficulty of our sacrifices. However, we are invited to look past our "Small Self"—the part of us defined by our successes, failures, and labels—to rediscover our **True Self** in God.

If we are truly immersed in God's presence, it means that at our very core, there is a "divine spark" that can never be lost, earned, or thrown away. We often spend our lives trying to build a tower of worthiness to reach Heaven, forgetting that we were created from the very "stuff" of God. Our primary task is not to become "holy" through sheer willpower (yes, we are called to become holy but not by self demand!), but to realize that we are already "whole" because we belong to God.

Awareness, in this sense, is a homecoming. It is like a mirror being wiped clean of dust. The mirror doesn't have to "do" anything to reflect the light; it simply has to be clear. This Lent, let your final push toward Easter be a process of clearing away the dust of shame and self-judgment.

**Reflect:** *If I stopped trying to "fix" myself, would I be able to see the Divine image already dwelling within me?*

### Pope Leo XIV Prayer for Disarmament and Peace

Lord of Life, you shaped every human being in your image and likeness. We believe you created us for communion, not for war, for fraternity, not for destruction. You who greeted your disciples saying, "Peace be with you," grant us the gift of your peace and the strength to make it a reality in history. Today we lift up our prayer for peace in the world, asking that nations renounce weapons and choose the path of dialogue and diplomacy.

Disarm our hearts of hatred, resentment, and indifference, so we may become instruments of reconciliation.

Help us understand that true security does not come from control fueled by fear, but from trust, justice, and solidarity among peoples. Lord, enlighten the leaders of the nations, so they may have the courage to abandon projects of death, halt the arms race, and place the lives of the most vulnerable at the center. May the nuclear threat never again dictate the future of humanity.

Holy Spirit, make us faithful and creative builders of daily peace: in our hearts, our families, our communities, and our cities. May every kind word, every gesture of reconciliation, and every choice for dialogue be seeds of a new world.

Amen.

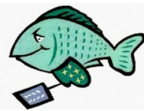

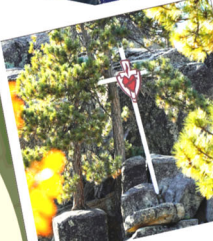
