5 SIMPLE WAYS TO CELEBRATE HOLY WEEK AT HOME

Create a simple prayer space in your home, and gather there to pray during the week.

Palm Sunday: At your regular Mass time, read the first Palm Sunday Gospel (Mt 21:1-11) and meditate on or discuss what Jesus might be thinking as he enters Jerusalem for the last time.

Holy Thursday: Bake bread for sharing at dinner; make a ritual of stripping the dinner table of all cloths and decorations after dinner.

Good Friday: Pray the Stations of the Cross at 3 p.m.

Holy Saturday: In the morning, read Psalm 64 and break your Good Friday fast solemnly with a simple meal.

Easter Sunday: Dress up the dinner table again. Include candles and crosses, so that the candy baskets aren't the only festive items present. Sing Alleluia and read the Easter Gospel (Matthew 28:1-10) with solemnity and joy.

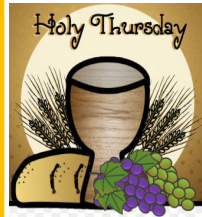

REFLECTION:

From the high hosanna acclamation to the low of betrayal, denial, and abandonment the Gospel take us up and down to the brink of life itself. Like the disciples, we also know who Jesus is. Every Sunday we make our profession of faith: "We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God..." This Palm Sunday we are invited to reflect on our own knowledge of who Jesus is and how well we confess him in our daily living. It is a daily choice to live the Gospel's requirement that we die to ourselves for the sake of others. This is how we confess Jesus as the Son of God. This is how, rather than denial and abandonment, we come to stand at the cross with Jesus. (*Living Liturgy, p 88*)

The Entrance into Reality: Presence Over Performance

As we wave our palms and join the procession today, we witness a King who does not need to "attain" power, for He is power itself made humble. The crowds shouting "Hosanna" are briefly **aware** of the Divine in their midst, yet as the week unfolds, that awareness will flicker and fade.

The tragedy of Passion Week is not that God leaves us, but that we lose sight of God when God doesn't look the way we expect. We want a God who conquers our enemies; We are given a God who suffers with us. We want a God "up there" on a throne; We are given a God "down here" in the dust.

Holy Week is the ultimate invitation to drop our scripts and our expectations. When we stop trying to manage God, we can finally begin to accompany God. As we enter these sacred days, let us pray for the grace of **uninterrupted awareness**, staying present to the One who is fully present to us, even to death on the Cross.

Reflect: *Am I following the Jesus I have created in my mind, or the Jesus who is actually standing before me?*

Pope Leo XIV Prayer for Disarmament and Peace

Lord of Life, you shaped every human being in your image and likeness.

We believe you created us for communion, not for war, for fraternity, not for destruction.

You who greeted your disciples saying, "Peace be with you," grant us the gift of your peace and the strength to make it a reality in history.

Today we lift up our prayer for peace in the world, asking that nations renounce weapons and choose the path of dialogue and diplomacy.

Disarm our hearts of hatred, resentment, and indifference, so we may become instruments of reconciliation.

Help us understand that true security does not come from control fueled by fear, but from trust, justice, and solidarity among peoples.

Lord, enlighten the leaders of the nations, so they may have the courage to abandon projects of death, halt the arms race, and place the lives of the most vulnerable at the center.

May the nuclear threat never again dictate the future of humanity.

Holy Spirit, make us faithful and creative builders of daily peace: in our hearts, our families, our communities, and our cities. May every kind word, every gesture of reconciliation, and every choice for dialogue be seeds of a new world.

Amen.
