**REFLECTION:**

Even on this most glorious of days, the gospel incorporates contradictions: Mary of Magdala arrives at an empty tomb, and sees that Jesus is gone and “we don’t know where they have put him” while the disciple whom Jesus loved enters the tomb and “saw and believed”; they “did not yet understand the Scripture.” Our own Alleluias and Easter joy are perhaps filled with some of the same contradictions. It seems as though we, too, peer into the empty tombs of the ups and downs of our everyday lives and are challenged to see and believe. But we are the disciples whom Jesus loves; and we surrender ourselves to the Easter mystery when we return love. All we need to do is hand ourselves over into God’s hands. Filled with God’s love, we are then able to love in return. Alleluia! The tomb is empty; by our love we see and believe, and we are filled with new life. Alleluia! *(Living Liturgy, p.112)*

Help us understand that true security does not come from control fueled by fear, but from trust, justice, and solidarity among peoples.

Lord, enlighten the leaders of the nations, so they may have the courage to abandon projects of death, halt the arms race, and place the lives of the most vulnerable at the center.

May the nuclear threat never again dictate the future of humanity.

Holy Spirit, make us faithful and creative builders of daily peace: in our hearts, our families, our communities, and our cities. May every kind word, every gesture of reconciliation, and every choice for dialogue be seeds of a new world.

Amen.

### The Great Awakening: The Victory of Union

Alleluia! The stone is rolled away, not to let Christ out, but to let us in—into a new reality where death has no sting and separation is no more. The Resurrection is the final, definitive proof that we are **immersed in God**. Even the grave could not create a barrier between the Human and the Divine.

Easter is the "Great Awakening." It is the moment we realize that the Light we sought throughout Lent was never extinguished; it was merely waiting for us to open our eyes. In the Risen Christ, the "illusion of separation" is shattered forever. We see that our humanity and God's divinity are woven together in a seamless garment of life.

Today, we don't just celebrate an event that happened 2,000 years ago; we celebrate a reality that is happening **now**. Christ is risen, and because He is risen, everything—every blade of grass, every breath we take, every neighbor we love—is vibrating with the life of God. Our Lenten journey of awareness has led us home.

**Reflect:** *Now that I have seen the Light of the Resurrection, how will I carry this awareness into the world?*
