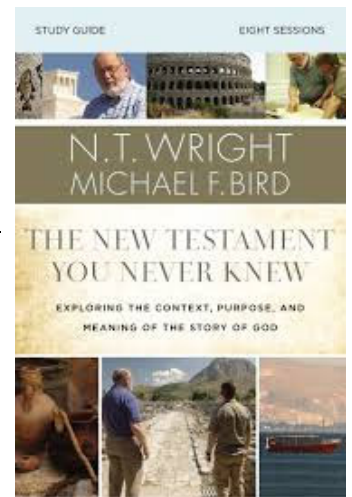
After which we will begin to explore the synoptic Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke, one at a time, beginning with Matthew in November.

Honoring the Sacred Heart of Jesus

The month of June is traditionally dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Devotion to the Sacred Heart invites us to contemplate the immense love and mercy of Christ, symbolized by His physical heart. This devotion has deep roots in our Catholic tradition, tracing back to the Middle Ages and growing in prominence through the visions of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17th century. Jesus Himself revealed His Heart as a symbol of His boundless love and invited us to return that love through devotion and prayer.

The Sacred Heart represents Jesus' human and divine love, His wounded and merciful love, and His passionate and compassionate love. It is a powerful reminder of His sacrifice for our salvation and the depth of His compassion for humanity.

How can the Sacred Heart be honored this month?

- Offer the days to the Sacred Heart: Begin each day with a Morning Offering, consecrating prayers, works, joys, and sufferings to Jesus through the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
- Venerate the image of the Sacred Heart: Jesus promised special blessings to those who honor His Sacred Heart image. Displaying and praying before an image of the Sacred Heart can help keep His love at the forefront.
- Make a Holy Hour: Spending time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, especially on Thursdays, is a way to console Jesus' Sacred Heart and grow closer to Him in the Eucharist.
- Participate in the First Friday devotion: Receiving Holy Communion on the first Friday of nine consecutive months, in reparation for sins against His Sacred Heart, brings us closer to Christ and allows us to share in the graces He offers.

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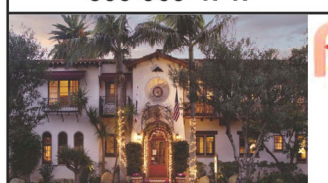
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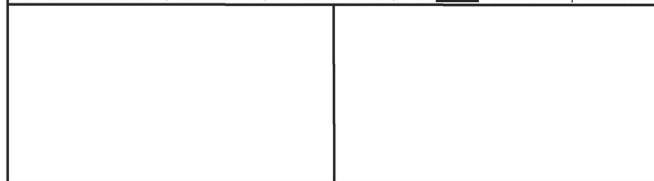
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
