REFLECTION:

Jesus responds to the lawyer's
question with a parable that illustrates
how keeping the law isn't a matter of
focusing on details regarding right or
wrong or personal gain, but is a
matter of right relationships with
one's neighbor as exhibited by acting
with compassion and mercy. The
Samaritan in the parable isn't moved
to help the stricken traveler because of
the law but because he was a person
of compassion and mercy. This is the
law written within our hearts—not
details about keeping specific laws but
a general regard for the other that
arises out of genuine care for the
other.

MEDITATION:

"There are scripture scholars who say that there is a subtle
twist to the end of the parable. Jesus asks the lawyer:
*"Which of these three, in your opinion, was neighbor to the
man who fell in with robbers?"* The answer came, "The one
who treated him with mercy." It would seem that in asking
the lawyer that question, Jesus was saying equivalently to
him, *"You asked Me 'who was my neighbor?' That was not
a good question. The question you should have asked me was
"To whom can I BE a neighbor? And the answer to that question is, 'the first poor person you
meet on the road."*

Safeguard The Children

Did you know?

What makes a child feel safe enough to disclose abuse?

There are several factors that contribute to whether a child is comfortable disclosing abuse to an adult. Children are more likely to talk about problems when they: have access to an adult they can trust; are able to understand that what is happening to them is not normal or safe; and trust that they will be believed. Another factor that may help a child disclose abuse is when a safe adult is intentional and asks direct questions about a child's life as it communicates caring and attention to the child's life circumstances. 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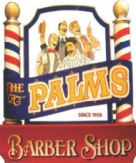
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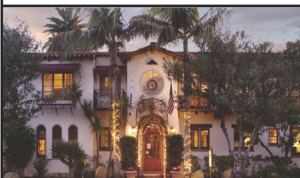
