REFLECTION:

Martha's hospitality was made edgy because of her becoming burdened with the cooking and serving. Martha is settling to be a servant where Jesus is looking for disciples. Mary's hospitality was gracious because she focused her attention on Jesus. The surprise is that Jesus affirms that the "better part" is to sit and listen—both metaphors for discipleship. The "better part" is to be a disciple! Before we can carry on the mission of Jesus as disciples, we must become disciples by sitting as the feet of Jesus listening to him. Practically speaking, this means being attentive to the Scriptures during Mass. It also means taking the time to be with Jesus in prayer—not just saying prayers but being quiet and listening to how Jesus speaks to our hearts.

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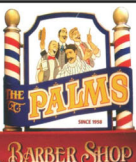
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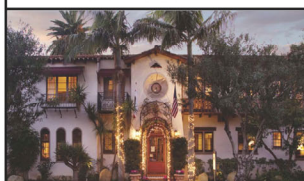



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
