REFLECTION:

The Gospel passage continues the theme of God's abundant providence with the feeding of the multitude. This banquet that Jesus offers is set in contrast to the banquet that Herod provided in the preceding verses that ended in the death of John the Baptist. The banquet that Jesus offers promotes and sustains life. The feeding of the multitude is a prefiguration of the Eucharist, which will be a sharing in the eternal messianic banquet.

Jesus meets the need of the crowd in their lack and their poverty. Jesus also seeks to meet us. If we do not recognize our poverty, if we do not have a need, then what Jesus offers is of little value. When we realize our need, then there is room for Jesus to enter our life at that moment. It is also there that we recognize our need for one another and become a community of followers. Our American perspective is very individualistic. There is great emphasis on doing it ourselves. The Gospel perspective is that we can never do it all by ourselves. We continually need God and one another to come to the fullness of life.

We welcome Bishop Rayarala Vijaya Kumar, P.I.M.E who is currently serving as the Bishop of the Diocese of Srikakulam in Andhra Pradesh, India. On **July 16, 2019**, Pope Francis appointed Bishop Rayarala Vijay Kumar as the Bishop of Srikakulam in India. His ministry has been marked by a deep commitment to marginalized communities, particularly individuals affected by leprosy. His leadership at the Leprosy Rehabilitation Center in Bombay and the establishment of the **'House of Mercy'** in **Taloja** near Mumbai exemplify his dedication to social outreach and interfaith collaboration.

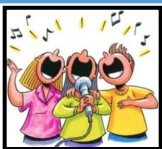


Bishop Rayarala continues to shepherd the Diocese of Srikakulam, focusing on:

- pastoral care, social justice and spiritual growth of his community
- evangelization among the tribal communities
- spiritual and pastoral formation of seminarians, clergy and religious
- education of children and women

- sewing, carpentry and constructing schools for dropouts
- regular medical care for the sick and elderly in remote areas
- construction of chapels in mission stations

The Loop of Grace

Evangelization and Christ-Centered Action

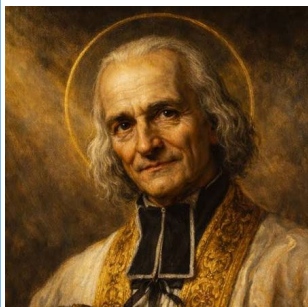
August often brings a slower pace to our lives, but our spiritual journey never takes a vacation. The primary task of the Christian life is the cultivation of a deep, personal relationship with Jesus Christ, which must then overflow into the world.

True discipleship is not a passive state of mind; it is an active mission. **When we center our lives on Christ, we begin to see the world through His eyes**, transforming how we treat our families, how we conduct ourselves at work, and how we respond to the poor.

This dynamic can be understood as the "loop of grace." The more we receive God's love through prayer, Scripture, and the Sacraments, the more we are compelled to give it away. Grace is a gift that diminishes if we try to hoard it, but multiplies the moment we share it (the Law of the Gift!) Our weekly participation in the Eucharist is meant to ignite this loop, filling us with divine life so that we can be sent forth to sanctify the culture.

As we move through this month, let us ask ourselves: Is Jesus the absolute center of my life, or is he just a hobby on the margins? Is attending Mass on Sunday one activity among others? Let us renew our commitment to daily prayer and weekly Mass. From this core of divine love, we find the strength to bring the light of the Gospel to places of darkness and division.

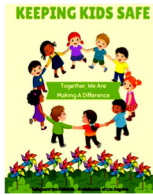
St. John Vianney (Feast: August 4) Model of Active Discipleship

Known as the Curé of Ars, St. John Vianney is the patron saint of parish priests and a powerful example of the "loop of grace." He did not hoard his spiritual gifts; instead, he poured himself out for his people, often spending up to 16 hours a day in the confessional. He famously said, "The priesthood is the love of the heart of Jesus." His life reminds us that true discipleship requires us to be conduits of God's mercy, tirelessly offering the love we receive from Christ to a world in need of healing.

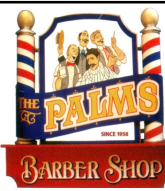

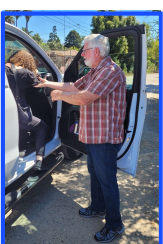
