**REFLECTION:**

This Gospel does show Jesus as having authority over the waters: he walks on the sea and at his will the wind dies down. Nevertheless, this Gospel is less about Jesus manifesting power in great events than it is an invitation to respond to Jesus, to come to him. We follow Jesus not because he is a great miracle worker but because he is the "Son of

God." It is far easier to come to Jesus in the obvious things; for example, faithful attendance at Mass. It is far more difficult to see God in the little things; for example, being pleasant when the poor are demanding, or giving back to a cashier too much change, or giving extra time to be present to children or spouse. (*Living Liturgy, p.212*)

Unmasking the False Self

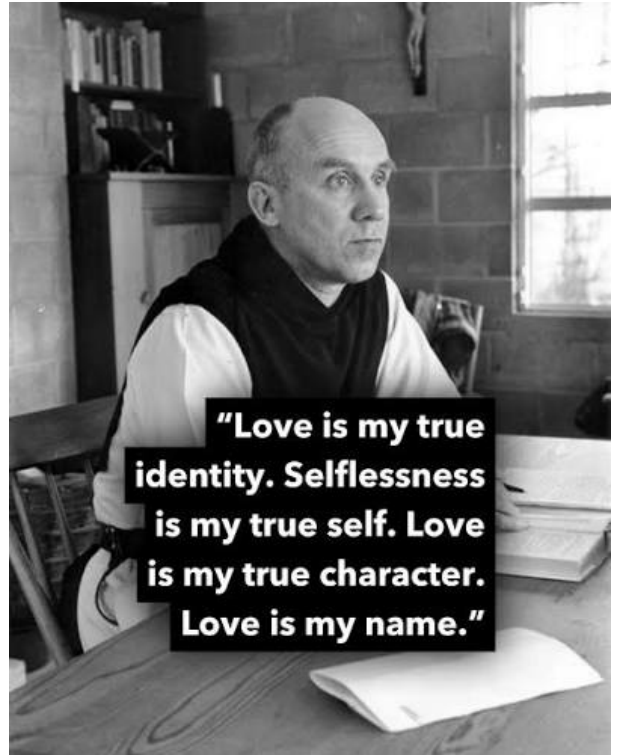
Contemplation and Identity in God

In our fast-paced culture, we easily fall into the trap of defining ourselves by our achievements, our possessions, or what others think of us. This creates a "false self"—a fragile mask we wear to survive in a competitive world, driven by anxiety and the need for approval. The spiritual tradition warns us that this mask eventually suffocates the soul. Our true identity cannot be manufactured; it can only be found hidden in God.

To discover the true self, we must enter into the silence of contemplation. To be made in the image of God means that unconditional love is the very reason for our existence. When we sit quietly with the Lord, away from the noise of our screens and daily anxieties, we strip away the illusions of the false self. We encounter the profound truth that we are deeply loved by God exactly as we are, before we do anything to earn it.

This week, try to carve out ten minutes of absolute silence each day. Do not ask God for anything; simply rest in God's presence. Allow God to love you, and let that love dissolve your insecurities, revealing the beautiful, true self God created you to be.

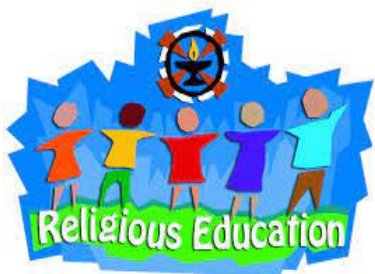


San Roque (Feast: August 16)

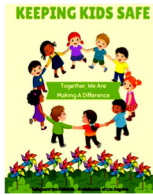
Patron of the Sick and Suffering

This week we honor our parish patron, San Roque (St. Roch). Born to nobility in France, he abandoned a life of comfort to care for victims of the plague in Italy, curing many with the sign of the cross. When he eventually contracted the disease himself and was banished to the forest, God provided for him through a dog that brought him bread daily. San Roque embodies the mystery of finding God in "disorder." He teaches us that even in our isolation and sickness, we are never abandoned. His life invites us to trust that God sustains us in our deepest suffering.

Characteristics of developmentally appropriate behaviors

It is important to distinguish normal, age-appropriate curiosity from concerning sexual behaviors that may be inappropriate or potentially abusive. In general, developmentally appropriate behaviors will be playful, curious, and will be enacted among similar age groups. While these behaviors are not ideal in play, and should be discussed with children, they are typically not causes for concern. These moments can also serve as opportunities to talk about boundaries, appropriate behaviors and safe adults. 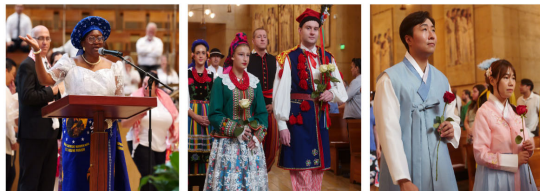
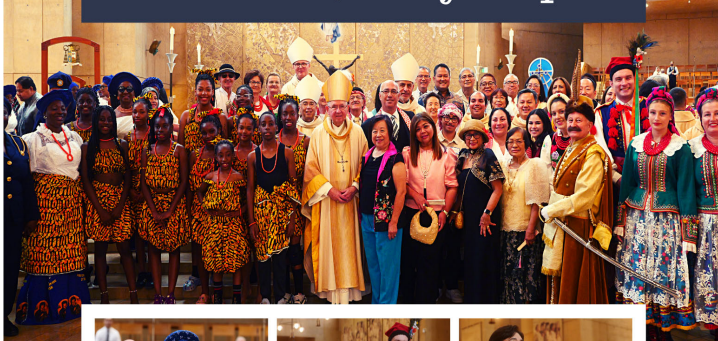
