REFLECTION:

A close reading of Luke 21:5-19 shows that using this passage as a springboard for proclaiming God's judgment on society would miss the point. Rather, the passage warns us about becoming too fixated on temporary human institutions, perhaps with the implication that we should attend to the poor in our communities instead, and it exhorts us to be firm in our trust in God when calamity and persecution strike. Despite its language and imagery of destruction, Luke 21:5-19 is ultimately a passage grounded in hope — in the hope that God remains present in the world and in one's life even when things have gotten so bad that it feels like the world is closing in on us.

* Notice Regarding Credit and Debit Card Donations *

We are deeply grateful to all our parishioners for your faithful and generous support of our parish. Please be advised that when donations are made using a credit/ATM/debit card, the parish has been paying a processing fee of **3.5%** for transactions, and when automatic bank transfers (ACH) are made, the parish has been paying **2.5%** on transactions. To cover these transaction charges and ensure that the full intended amount benefits the parish, this small processing fee (**3.5%**) for credit/ATM/debit cards and (**2.5%**) for ACH payments is being added.

Those who wish to avoid this additional charge may continue to make their offerings by cash, check, or other methods that do not incur processing fees.

This coming Liturgical year is the year of Matthew (we hear predominantly from Matthew's Gospel). The Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary (November 21st)

On **November 21st**, the Church celebrates the **Feast of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary**. While not explicitly described in the canonical Gospels, this feast is rooted in ancient Christian tradition, particularly the second-century *Protoevangelium of James*.

According to tradition, Mary's parents, Saints Joachim and Anne, who had long been childless, vowed to God that if they were blessed with a child, they would dedicate her to the Lord's service. In fulfillment of this promise, they brought Mary, around the age of three, to the Temple in Jerusalem to be raised among holy women and consecrated to God.

Significance of the Presentation:

Lifelong Dedication: This feast emphasizes Mary's profound holiness and total, lifelong dedication to God from her very childhood.

The New Temple: Mary lived a life of purity and prayer in the Temple, preparing her to become the ultimate "Temple of God" - the sacred vessel where Christ would take on flesh at the Incarnation.

Parental Faith: The feast highlights the exemplary faith of Saints Joachim and Anne, who selflessly surrendered their only daughter to God's will, teaching us about trusting our own families and plans to the Lord.

A Call to Consecration: The Presentation of Mary invites us to reflect on our own baptismal consecration and to renew our commitment to God's will in our lives. We are encouraged to emulate Mary's openness and obedience, striving to make our own hearts a dwelling place for God's grace.

Celebrating the Presentation of Mary offers us an opportunity to honor the purity of the Blessed Virgin and to ask for her intercession as we strive for holiness and a deeper "yes" to God in our own lives.

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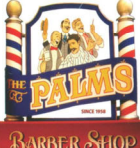
