Last year 24 of us visited the WWII Museum and the feedback that I got was very positive. So there are a couple of locations in the Springfield area that we can visit as a group if there is enough interest.

Please let me know your thoughts on visiting one or both of the following.

The Springfield Armory is a National Historic Site commemorating the role of the nation's first armory by preserving the world's largest U.S. Military small arms collection along with historic archives, buildings and landscapes.

The armory was the primary center for the manufacture of firearms from 1777 until its closing in 1968. Admission is free.

The Agawam Axe House is an indoor axe throwing facility. We can rent an area for 20 people who would like to learn or just watch axe throwing. As you might expect, this is a non-alcohol facility and should take about 90 minutes for a session. Fee to be determined by the number of participants. Advance reservations are a must.

I am thinking we could do one of the above on Friday and if there is interest one on Saturday afternoon.

There are a number of other nearby attractions including the MGM Casino, Yankee Candle, The New England Air Museum (\$13.00 for a group and 2 weeks' notice) and for those of you feeling nostalgic perhaps a trip to UMass might be your thing.
