REGISTRATION AND CODE OF CONDUCT

- We, the parents/guardian(s) of the (PLAYER REGISTERED) hereby give consent for participation in the above activity and do claim that he/she is in excellent physical condition and able to participate in said sport.
- We the parents/guardian(s) of (PLAYER REGISTERED) team player hereby gives my/our child approval to his/her participation in all league activities during the current season and assume all risks and hazards incidental to such participation including transportation to and from activities. I/we do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless the LYSA Association, Inc., coaches, and volunteer(s) the organizers, sponsors, supervisors, participants and persons transporting my/our child to and from the activities, for any claim arising out of an injury to my child, except to the extent and in the amount covered by the accident and/or liability insurance.
- I/We understand that registration fees are NON-REFUNDABLE. The ONLY refund granted will be PRIOR to the season due to medical reasons. (Doctors' note required). This will be a partial refund, which will be minus fees already incurred for the season. Additionally, (WHERE THIS MAY APPLY) I/We promise to return all uniforms and equipment unconditionally as issued to my child in as good condition as when received, except for normal wear and tear, on the last day of practice or immediately upon request from the coach or said equipment as well as legal costs associated with collection proceedings. (FOOTBALL and LAX ONLY) When you receive a borrowed helmet, you will be required to pay a \$40.00 cash fee. Parents Signature:
- I/We understand that volunteer coaches and their assistants are not babysitters and that a parent/guardian is required to attend all scheduled practices, games and extra events such as pep rallies, team parties and any such events requiring the presence of my child. It is not permissible to drop my child off and leave the area with my child unattended.
In the event that your contact info changes, it is your responsibility to inform the commissioner of your sport, as we will have no way of contacting you when the season begins.
