PILGRIMAGE TO BEAUREPAIRE PRIORY RUINS SATURDAY 19TH SEPTEMBER

For our pilgrimage this month we are going to walk from Langley Park to the ruins of Beaurepaire Priory near Bearpark. This is a round route of approximately 5 miles. The path is mainly level with just a couple of short uphill stretches and about 3 stiles to navigate.

As we are approaching harvest the focus of our walk is going to be giving thanks to God for his many blessings. You are invited to carry with you some small object which represents something you would like to say thank you to God for. This might be something like a photo of a place or people, or maybe a small object which has a particular significance to you. You don't have to show these to anyone, but there will be an opportunity along the way to bring our own personal prayers of thanksgiving to God. You are also invited to bring a verse of thanks or praise from the Bible upon which you can reflect as you walk and there will be an opportunity for anyone who would like to, to read their verse of scripture to the rest of the group when we pause to give thanks.

If you are not able to join us on the walk, you can still pilgrimage with God from your own home by making some time to just pause for your own time of reflection and thanksgiving.

This fully funded high-quality **Suicide Awareness and Prevention Training** is designed to equip individuals and communities with the confidence to recognise and respond to people who may be struggling. The training programmes are developed in partnership with local authorities and public health teams, ensuring they are **locally relevant, evidence-informed and focused on real community impact**. The programme is built upon 20+ years of experience in suicide prevention and postvention and comes from if you care share's deep roots in the North East community. Suicide prevention is everyone's responsibility. By increasing awareness and building confidence at a community level, we can:

- Identify warning signs earlier
- Support people before they reach crisis point
- Encourage safe and open conversations
- Help individuals access the right support

The programme is built on the principle that **the more people who feel confident to act, the more lives can be saved**. We would love as many people as possible in church and from the Lanchester area to attend to gain these important skills. Please feel free to invite others to attend also. Training is free and refreshments will be provided. No prior knowledge is needed. We have a maximum of 25 spaces but if exceed this number, we hope to run this training again.
