



Thank you for your interest in registering with us at Seaview Dental Practice.

We are up to capacity on our NHS lists and regret we are unable to take on any more patients on the NHS currently.

We have answered the most frequently asked questions from patients expressing an interest to register with us privately; we hope it may be of any assistance.

Appointment availability

A frequent question from patients is how quickly we can offer appointments. As an indication, new patient appointments for non-urgent examination appointments are available in around 3 weeks' time.

We will try our utmost to give patients in pain priority appointments. We have slots blocked each day for our existing patients so they can access us readily should they have severe pain, (as we know toothache sometimes comes without warning and can take over your day!).

These slots sometimes do not need to be utilised; we can then contact you by 11 am if you are able to come in at short notice for our 2 pm slots.

Costs

We have attached our indicative price list below. We will always discuss your treatment options with you and provide you with a written estimate before we commence treatment. We do not have a payment plan but provide the options to spread the costs on some long-term treatments like Invisalign clear aligners/Orthodontic treatment or Implant treatments.

Specialist Care

We provide routine general and cosmetic dentistry; we pride ourselves in an ethical and professional approach to our patient care. We treat our patients with respect and consideration and find that our friendliness and gentle manner puts most people at ease. It has been most rewarding to inspire patients who have avoided dentists for years to get back into routine care.

We provide Invisalign clear aligners and have a Specialist Orthodontist in the practice treating and advising on the more complex treatments.

We have a visiting Dentist with a special interest in Endodontics (root canal treatments) for the more complex root treatments.

A visiting Oral Surgeon helps us with complicated extractions -late evening appointments may be available for this.

We provide implant placement and restorations as part of a comprehensive treatment plan.
