Mateo 13, 1-23



La parábola del sembrador es la primera de las que aparecen en Mateo; es sencilla y está sacada del ambiente de la gente normal de la comunidad de Jesús; pero, a medida que la parábola se desarrolla, el sembrador pierde importancia. La parábola se centra en realidad en la semilla y en la tierra. Jesús habla de la receptividad de la tierra. Este modo de enseñanza era muy común, y no solamente de Jesús.



La palabra que cae en la buena tierra de nuestro corazón nos transforma en fruto del propio Cristo. ¿Cómo luciría ese fruto? Un fruto de Cristo es la persona paciente, amable, entregada y generosa que piensa más en el otro que en sí misma. Un fruto de Cristo es la persona que ofrece a los demás un espacio de paz, serenidad y amor. Un fruto de Cristo es la persona que brinda servicio a otros y cumple en su vida las obras de misericordia corporales o espirituales por las que se reconoce la presencia de Cristo en este mundo.

Las semillas caen en diferente tierra



Señor, hoy vengo a recibir tu Palabra, que es una pequeña semilla. Pero quiero que me hables claro sobre lo que necesito. No quiero, por mi parte, cerrar el corazón a esta pequeña semilla, sino recibirla con alegría. Para esto te pido fe, que me lleve a reconocer en tu semilla mi salvación y me permita acogerla. Necesito también confianza, para que tu semilla, Dios mío, crezca. Y por último pido amor, ese amor que hace fructificar en mi vida el ciento por uno. Señor, hazme dócil a tu Palabra; que te escuche con atención. Dame la "tierra buena", de la que tú hablas en el Evangelio, Señor. Que no sea sordo a tu voz.

Medita lo que Dios te dice en el Evangelio:

La semilla siempre es del sembrador. La tierra es lo que yo te puedo ofrecer. Bien sabes, Señor, el tipo de tierra que soy. Tal vez soy terreno pedregoso, o llena de espinos, o un simple camino, pero no dejes de lanzar en mí tu semilla porque, incluso en esos campos, puede que algún día crezca lo que sembraste. Si soy camino, ayúdame a romper el asfalto y buscar la tierra en la que puedas depositar tu semilla. Quiebra el cemento de mi soberbia, de mi orgullo, de mi vanidad. Taladra el egoísmo, la envidia y la pereza. Rompe esa capa de pavimento que se resiste a mostrar la tierra buena que hay

en mí; que no se ve, pero que sí está. Por eso te pido que, por más duro que pueda ser mi corazón, no dejes de sembrar en él tu Palabra, porque ella, tarde o temprano, penetrará y, germinando, producirá frutos, así como vemos a veces que en medio de las calles surgen pequeñas plantas, que si dejamos crecer pueden destruir las más resistentes capas de asfalto. Si soy terreno pedregoso, no te desanimes, Señor. Ayúdame con paciencia a ir sacando poco a poco todas esas piedras que impiden que tu semilla crezca sana y resistente. Ayúdame a recoger la piedra de la ira, del enojo o de la impaciencia. Toma las rocas de mi lujuria, de mi avaricia y aléjalas de mi campo. Ordena las piedras de mis defectos, de mis pecados y debilidades. Ayúdame, incluso, a ir recogiendo esas piedras grandes o pequeñas e ir las poniendo como cerco para custodiar la planta de tu Palabra. Si soy tierra llena de espinas sigue siempre lanzando tu mensaje. Juntos, Tú y yo podemos ir arrancando esas espinas que ocupan espacio sin producir nada fecundo en mi vida, y que, por el contrario, impiden que tu buena siembra crezca y produzca en mí. Las espinas de mi falsa apariencia, de la búsqueda de recompensa por todo lo que hago, de mis dobles intenciones, de mis chismes, de mis desánimos en la lucha por la santidad. Arranca de raíz las mentiras de mi vida, las imágenes falsas que aparento ante los demás. No permitas, Señor, que todas estas cosas ensucien mi campo y ahoguen tu Palabra. Si soy tierra buena, ayúdame a no

descuidarla y mantenerla siempre disponible para acoger tu Palabra y que siga produciendo frutos abundantes. No permitas que la siembra de espinas, o que la asfalto para resistirme a tus exigencias. No permitas que crezcan en mí las plantas de la soberbia que me pueden hacer creer mejor que los demás por ser campos no tan buenos como yo, o creer que yo mismo he merecido el campo que tengo, o que es toda obra mía el poseer y cultivar un campo así. Por el contrario, que sea tierra rica en virtudes, en actitudes y sentimientos santos que acoja tu semilla y la haga crecer y fructificar según tus designios.

Diálogo con Cristo: Señor, hoy me has hablado claro, sé que solo con escucharte y recibirte en la Eucaristía no pereceré en este desierto que es el mundo. También me has mostrado mi ingratitud para contigo, especialmente cuando no hago fructificar tus semillas: aquellas gracias y oportunidades para crecer en el amor y en la paciencia, porque he cerrado mi corazón. Pero ahora te pido de rodillas, que ya no dejes pasar mis días sin amarte, viendo en todo tu mano de Padre, y rezando con el corazón y no con la boca.
