El biógrafo destaca las tres facetas de Salomón como sabio, constructor y rico; pero lo más importante en él es la sabiduría. Dios había dado a Salomón una inteligencia y una sabiduría extraordinarias. Salomón fue un buen administrador y político; su sabiduría se extendió a las letras y a las artes; pero, para Salomón, lo más importante, lo que pedía en su oración, era "sabiduría de corazón".



El que se diga que todo es para el bien de los que aman a Dios no se debe entender como que todo se va a arreglar. Eso llevaría a las personas a la desilusión al haber creído que Dios evitaría dolores y problemas. El Reino de los Cielos se parece a un tesoro



Oración Introductoria:
Señor mío y Dios mío,
concédeme la gracia de
encontrar el tesoro de tu
Palabra para hacer crecer
tu Reino en mi corazón.

Vengo ante ti para mostrarte mi pobreza y para pedirte que concedas lo que más necesito para serte fiel, para amarte más y para llevarte a los demás. Concédeme una fe inquebrantable y una confianza que me haga esperarlo todo de ti, mi único Bien. Jesús manso y humilde de Corazón, haz mi corazón semejante al tuyo. Haz que mis sentimientos sean los tuyos, que mis pensamientos sean los tuyos y que mi voluntad sea la tuya para agradarte a ti y edificar a los demás.

Meditación: Cada uno de nosotros somos un negociante de perlas finas. En la vida vamos buscando las más bellas y las mejores. Las buscamos en la felicidad, en nuestras relaciones con nuestros familiares y amigos, en el trabajo y también en el éxito de cada una de nuestras obras. Pero estas joyas carecen de valor cuando descubrimos que sólo una las supera en belleza y precio. Ese diamante precioso de valor incalculable será siempre Dios, que brilla en cada uno de sus lados: su Palabra en el Evangelio, su gracia, sus dones, sus virtudes, la vida eterna. Si somos buenos comerciantes, seremos capaces de vender todo con tal de adquirir el campo donde hemos encontrado la joya que verdaderamente vale. Y en términos de inversio-

nes, la herencia por la que hay que luchar en la vida es la eterna: ¡hay que invertir en el cielo! San Pablo nos dice que si hemos resucitado con Cristo, busquemos las cosas de arriba, donde no hay ni ladrones ni polilla que pueda corroer nuestro tesoro. ¿Cuáles son nuestras joyas? ¿Dónde está nuestro tesoro? ¿Dónde está nuestro corazón? ¿Dónde queremos que esté? Puesto en lo que no pasará, porque no queremos cosas que perecen y se acaban. Deseamos llevarnos lo único que podemos tener después de la muerte: nuestras buenas obras y el amor con que hemos vivido y que hemos transmitido a los demás. Por este motivo, hay que escoger, como dice el pasaje del Evangelio, lo bueno y tirar lo malo. Hay que desechar de nuestra vida lo que no agrada a Dios, lo que hiera a las demás personas que nos rodean y guardar lo que realmente sirve, en el “cesto” que llevaremos con nosotros mismos y que presentaremos delante de Dios. ¿Ya está lleno o aún falta? Pues comencemos a trabajar por este Reino porque aún es tiempo de merecer.

Reflexión Apostólica: Cristo trata de ilustrar con ejemplos y escenas de la vida diaria lo que podría compararse con el Reino de los cielos al que Él se refiere. La gente de entonces lo entendía bien porque se dedicaban a esos menesteres. Hoy también entendemos los ejemplos de Jesús, pero el materialismo, el hedonismo y la falta de sentido no nos dejan aplicarnos a trabajar por este Reino de los cielos. Parece que entendemos mucho pero trabajamos poco. Hay que trabajar para

la eternidad. San Pablo dice que “quien sembrar en su carne, de la carne cosechará la corrupción; pero quien siembre en el Espíritu, del Espíritu cosechará la vida eterna” (Gal 6, 8). Este es el tesoro que todos buscamos: gozar de Dios en la felicidad eterna, pero que no acertamos a encontrarlo porque para poseerlo, primero hay que creer en él sin verlo. Quien encuentra el tesoro escondido, es capaz de dejarlo todo por conseguirlo; quien encuentra la perla fina, nunca la vuelve a dejar; quien ha obtenido el trabajo de una buena pesca, sabrá desechar lo malo y quedarse con lo bueno. Los santos han constatado que esto es real y verdadero. Si buscamos, hay que estar seguros de que encontraremos, porque el comenzar a buscar a Dios es haberlo encontrado ya (cfr. San Agustín).

Diálogo con Cristo: Oh sacratísimo Corazón de Jesús que estás inflamado de amor por mí, concédeme abrirte mi corazón para que lo enciendas de amor por ti. Ayúdame, Señor, valorar mi vida de cara a la eternidad, para que así no pueda menos que trabajar por tu gloria y buscar las cosas del cielo, donde me tienes un lugar que me has ganado por tu pasión, muerte y resurrección. Quiero encontrarte, Señor, sé Tú mi tesoro por el cual venda todo mi pecado a cambio de tu gracia. Quiero poseerte, se Tú mi piedra preciosa, mi pesca milagrosa y el puerto seguro al que me lleve tu mano amorosa para gozar de ti por toda la eternidad.
