“This Is Us”

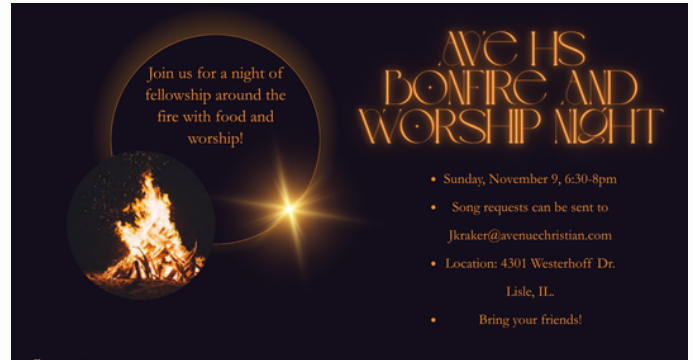

Financial Update

The first quarter of our fiscal year (July - June) has wrapped up with a deficit (see below). Both actual giving/income and expenses are below the projected budget. There were some unexpected expenses that took place this quarter, including fixing the HVAC units for the Foyer area in our church. We are also grateful for a variety of different people who have volunteered their time and talents to help with painting certain rooms and updating flooring in the church office when the carpet was unsalvageable due to water damage.
