<p>HOW WE USE THIS INFORMATION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To provide tailored support to our Supported Volunteers • To ensure the safety and security of all Supported Volunteers attending our service. • To communicate important information to agreed organisations and people. 	
<p>INFORMATION SHARING AND DISCLOSURE We do not sell, rent or trade personal information to third parties. However, we may share information in the following circumstances:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • With consent, we may share information with third parties involved in your care and support e.g. Social Services, NHS, carers • Safeguarding, if we genuinely believe an individual may be harmed or at risk of harm. • Legal requirement, if required to do so by law. • We will provide employer references on request, these will be provided on a private and confidential basis. 	

LEGAL RIGHTS AND CHOICES

- You have the right to ask us to delete information if we no longer have good reason for keeping it.
- You have the right to ask us to make your data available in an accessible format to allow for portability.
