CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Beanies and entries must be received before the close of business, Friday 29th May 2026.

Late entries will be returned COD Please note it takes 3 weeks for parcels to arrive in Alice Springs so prepare early. Please send a pre paid post pack for return beanies or we will send it in a box COD which can be expensive. Please do not send hat stands or teapots with your entry.

1 The Favourite Beanie Festival Memory Prize

For a beanie that tells a story of your favourite beanie memory from the past 30 years...a moment, a friend made, the colour, the joy spread.

2 Your Dream Beanie Prize

This is the beanie you have always dreamed of making..go wild...this is your moment to shine!

We are so humbly grateful for your involvement in the festival for so many years...what are you grateful for in your life?

4 The Most Glorious Beanie Ever Prize

What is the most exquisite beanie you ever imagined...attention to detail, colour, form and imagination...perfection in a beanie.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) All entries must have arrived by last mail 29 May 2026. No discussion will be entered into. No extensions possible.
- 2) Each competitor may enter <u>two</u> pieces into the competition. <u>The First entry must be for sale, the second</u> can be for sale or not for sale.
- 3) **Sales:** There is a tendency to underprice the work, so please consider all your costs materials, postage, entry fees, commission, effort etc.
- 4) Entries to be sent to: Alice Springs Beanie Festival, Araluen Arts Centre, PO Box 3521, Alice Springs NT 0871
- 5) Each entry must be delivered with:
- i) Entry fee: a non-refundable entry fee of \$20 per beanie/teacosy. Payment can be made by cash or money order to the Alice Springs Beanie Festival. International entries payment made by bank deposit Pls email beaniefestival@gmail.com for details..
- **ii) Return of unsold work:** Send a <u>prepaid</u> postpack with your name on it for us to return your work, or we will box it up and send it COD (this can be expensive) Please tick box below.
- **iii) Identification Label:** The artists name, address and price must be marked and firmly stitched (not pinned) to the inside crown of the beanie. Please use a cloth tag (you only need to do this for competition beanies).
- **iv) Beanie Festival Swingtag must** also be attached so that it hangs out of the beanie from the inside crown in an obvious way, with the price clearly written.
- v) Barcode We will attach a barcode to your entry as we receive it and note it on your entry form.
- vi) Entry Form: a completed and signed entry form.

vii) Artists statement/Beanie Stories (optional): Please send an artist statement with your work in a one page A4 format.

If your work is in a particular cultural/family tradition we would love to know the origins of your work, e.g. send a story about your work, a story about your making. This will be placed in an A4 folder within the exhibition space and possibly used in festival publications.

- 6) All entries will be seen by the judges.
- 7) Any entries that are not displayed within the Araluen Gallery will be displayed as part of the Beanie Central Exhibition.
- 8) <u>50</u>% commission will be taken from the asking price by the Araluen Gallery (40%) and the Beanie Festival (10%).
- 9) **Payment from sold work:** Payment for sold works will be made by bank transfer as soon as possible after the close of the exhibition (July 20th) Please double check your bank details as incorrect numbers will cause delay in payments
- 10) While all care will be taken with the entries, no responsibility will be accepted for lost or damaged items, by the Alice Springs Beanie Festival or the Araluen Arts Centre. Insurance remains the responsibility of the artist.
- 11) The Beanie Festival reserves the right to use images of the works entered free of charge for any promotion or publication. Apart from this, copy right resides with the entrant.
- 12) All entries must have been produced after 1 July 2025 and not previously exhibited.
- 14) **Unsold work:** All unsold work will be returned to the artist. Please note on the entry form how you would like your piece returned and include a PREPAID post pack or COD paperwork with entry fee if appropriate.
