

Katie Beckett Resources

We know completing the Katie Beckett application is a daunting process. Please carefully review the following tip sheets and websites before submitting the forms to Northside Peds for review. **The physician forms should have all the information you are able to enter about your child and their required care, prior to submission at NSP.** Your child's physician will then review the information you have entered, make additions and/or corrections and sign the forms. At times, we may need to schedule a visit to review the forms to ensure that all the most up to date information is included so that your child has the best chance of being approved. Due to the extensive nature of these forms, we need at least 2 weeks to review and sign them. Also, please be aware that some families hire a service/professional to complete the forms (see list below).
