



2026 Jackass Half Marathon VOLUNTEER Scholarship (\$1,500)

This scholarship was created by the committee for the Jackass Half Marathon and 5K which is put on by the Silver Valley Chamber of Commerce. This race started in 2020 and invites runners from all over the Silver Valley and all over the country to run 13.1 miles on the Trail of the Coeur d'Alenes from Wallace to Kellogg. This event would not be able to take place without more than 100 volunteers who generously donate their time and efforts. The Silver Valley Chamber of Commerce relies heavily upon the generosity of volunteers throughout our community and would like to help inspire a younger generation of community-minded adults. The winner of this scholarship will win a free registration for the 2024 Jackass Half Marathon or 5K as well as a \$1,500 scholarship.

This scholarship was created in hopes of assisting high school graduates with an interest and focus in volunteerism to fund their post-secondary education. In order to qualify to receive this scholarship, the applicant must fulfill the following criteria:

- be a graduate of either Kellogg High School, Wallace High School, or Mullan High School
- illustrate a passion for community service and involvement and produce an organized list of the volunteer activities he/she has participated in throughout high school
- submit a letter of recommendation, a résumé, and high school transcripts
