Dippen Hall, Eastbourne Road, Blindley Heath, Lingfield, Surrey, RH7 6JX – a planning application was submitted (ref 2024/998) whereby "Erection of 7 dwellings, car parking and associated landscaping to the rear of Dippen Hall." - such application subsequently withdrawn.

Mike advised that Surrey County Council wanted the speed limit here reduced to 40mph and that it was expecting the developer to pay for this speed reduction.

Devolution and Local Government Reorganisation (LGR) Surrey County Council has been selected by the government to fast track as a Unitary therefore concrete proposals need to be submitted by SCC to the government regarding its plans by 8 May. Eight out of the 11 district and borough councils would like three unitaries whilst SCC would prefer two.

There is concern regarding the level of debt in several districts and boroughs to the west of the county and that those generally in the east do

f. Godstone road collapse

It is two months since the collapse. There was a productive meeting between TDC and SCC on 22 April to ensure SCC's priorities were clear. There are issues regarding communications from SCC in as much as there is a lack of communication seemingly.

There is another public meeting to come soon to publish timelines. Of the 34 families forced out, only two families have not returned to their properties.


