Project Requirements:

1. One exhibit allowed per class.
2. Artwork must be matted on a firm surface. Acceptable material can be matting board, cardstock, foam board or stiff poster board.
3. Matting must include a 2" border around the artwork.
4. Matting does not apply to canvas artwork.
5. Avoid glues or adhesives that will damage your artwork or leak through your project.
