## **Project Requirements:**

1. Open to all 4-H clubs and individuals in the county.
2. Placement of display is on a first-come, first-serve basis.  
Entry forms are due in the Fair Office by 8 a.m. on Monday and must clearly define the display's location and map provided.
3. Displays to remain in place from 8 a.m. Monday through 10 p.m. on Saturday. Displays may be set up as early as Saturday prior to the fair, after 6 p.m.
4. Displays must be structurally sound, able to withstand the weather that may be unpredictable.
5. You can build upon your display year to year, as long as there is some change to the display.
6. Award winners will be announced during Opening Ceremonies on Monday.
7. Clubs must fill out an online entry form to receive Award.
8. Exhibitor(s) are responsible for maintaining their display the week of fair.

## Judging Criteria:

- Container complimentary to the location it is placed.
- Flowers and plant containers must be fresh, healthy and complimentary to display and location.
- Overall appearance of entry.

## **Division 7501 – Interactive Display**

These displays will provide an opportunity for fair visitors to interact with your display. For example: Photo ops, seating areas, etc.

**Class 01** - 4-H Club or Group

**Class 02** - Individual

## **Division 7502 – Non-Interactive Display**

These displays will compliment an area of the fairgrounds. These are standing displays that are non-interactive to the public. For example: plants and flowering container gardens, displays made from “upcycled” or repurposed materials, etc.
