## Project Requirements:

1. Exhibitors must train and care for their cat exhibit.
2. Exhibitors shall exhibit no more than two cat/kitten.
3. Cats are required to be brought to the fair in a carrier suitable for their size on judging day. If exhibitor will be at the fairgrounds for judging in other departments or will be setting up other areas it is suggested that you bring a small litter box and a bigger cage with a cover.
4. Required vaccinations for all cats are rabies, FVRCP and feline leukemia. Exhibitor must submit proof of vaccinations on or before July 1 to superintendent at justinboots4h@gmail.com or to fair office, SCCAS, P.O. Box 325, Marysville, MI 48040, or drop a copy off at Fair Office or MSU Extension.
5. All cats must have their nails clipped. (A safety factor for exhibitor and judge).
6. Exhibitor attire should be neat and clean.
7. Noticeably pregnant or nursing cats, and kittens under four months of age are ineligible for show.
8. Female cats in season are eligible for show but should be kept in a carrier away from the showing.
9. Exhibitors must submit a 4x6 photo of themselves and their cat(s) for display in the still exhibit barn.

## Division 2401 – Cat Showmanship

**Class 01** - Senior Cat Showmanship 16 yrs. & over

**Class 02** - Intermediate Cat Showmanship 13-15 yrs. old

**Class 03** - Junior Cat Showmanship 11 & 12 yrs. old

**Class 04** - Young Cat Showmanship 8-10 yrs. old

**Class 05** - Clover Sprout Cat Showmanship 5-7 yrs. old

Agility: Exhibitors will lure their cat through a predetermined obstacle course. Exhibitors must provide their own cat toys or treats as incentives. Cats must be in a well fitted harness and leash to participate.

## Division 2403 – Cat Agility

**Class 01** - Senior Agility 16 yrs. & over

**Class 02** - Intermediate Agility 13-15 yrs. old

**Class 03** - Junior Agility 11 & 12 yrs. old

**Class 04** - Young Agility 8-10 yrs. old

**Class 05** - Clover Sprout Agility 5-7 yrs. old

## Division 2402 - Cat Displays

Exhibitors do not have to own a cat to enter a poster, but you must be present for judging. Interviews will take place during the cat show.

**Class 06** - Cat care/training poster

Criteria for judging: Accurate information, presentation of information is legible, creativity, originality and neatness.

Posters are to be brought to the cat show and exhibitor will interview during that time.

**Class 07** - Cat Breed Research

Exhibitor will research a particular breed of cat and exhibit that knowledge in poster form or in another form of display.

**Class 08** - Cat Emergency procedures for pets.

Exhibitor will research what are simple first aid procedures that can be done for their animal at home and what requires a vet visit. Possible topics also include evacuation procedures for pets, pet first aid kits, etc.

**Class 09** - Cat Scrapbook

Exhibitor will create a scrapbook containing at least 5 pages. Pages must contain labels or notes identifying what is happening in the pictures. Focus may be on any aspect of cat ownership or the exhibitor.
