

COLLECTIONS

1. To learn information and gain knowledge about the specific collection the member is collecting.
2. To be able to share the information and knowledge gained with others.
3. Members will be required to exhibit a **Project Report Form** with their collection to share information and demonstrate their knowledge.
4. Set individual goals for the collection, including expansion for the next year and into the extended future.

DISPLAYING THE PROJECT

The project display should be, NEAT, ORDERLY, (so all items of the collection can be seen, space is limited to 2'x3') and ATTRACTIVE. Members are encouraged to use their imagination when putting together their collection display. Photos of entire collection are acceptable to supplement the display but not to replace it.
