Project Requirements:

1. Exhibitors may bring live animals, cavy, bird, fish, etc. for judging, but it is not required.
2. No live animals will be left on the fairgrounds, only exhibits.
3. Each exhibit must include:
 - At least one good picture of the pet and owner.
 - A Pocket Pet Report Form (Found on website at www.stclaircounty4hfair.org)
 - An exhibit, poster, notebook, or combination of these on the pet, its care and feeding, and information on the type of animal it is. Poster size 14"x22"
 - Exhibit must include at least one point of information pertinent to the pet.
4. Exhibitors must help set up and clean up.
5. Pet must be alive.
6. Suggested display: Cage, photo album, diary, small keepsake, mobile, photo wreath
7. Exhibitors limited to 2 entries.

Division 2501 – Pocket Pets

Pocket Pet such as cavy (guinea pig), bird, cat, dog, fish, gerbil, hamster, mice, insects, rats, reptiles, other.

Class 01 - Pocket Pet, age 16 & over

Class 02 - Pocket Pet, age 13-15 yrs. old

Class 03 - Pocket Pet, age 8-12 yrs. old

Class 04 - Pocket Pet Clover Sprout, age 5-7 yrs. old
