## Project Requirements:

1. A prospect beef may not be over seven months of age or over 600 lbs.
2. All prospect beef must be weaned by time of fair.
3. Male beef must be castrated and dehorned with no visible signs of decay, trauma, drainage, and hanging at fair. Calves must be fully healed.
4. Prospect beef will not be sold at the livestock auction.
5. Prospect beef will have their own show before the large beef show. Allowing exhibitors to show large beef and prospect beef in each respective showmanship classes.
6. Prospect beef will be weighed in at the same time as the beef, Sunday at fair.
7. Prospect beef can be a beef, dairy, dairy beef, crossbred beef in the show.
8. Classes will be divided at the discretion of the superintendents.
9. A RFID tag must be in animal's ear.
10. All grooming/fitting rules for the beef project apply to the prospect beef.
