BAPTISM

The presiding minister baptizes each candidate.

P: Let us pray... we give you thanks, O God, that through water and the Holy Spirit you give your daughters and sons new birth, cleanse them from sin, and raise them to eternal life.

Laying both hands on the head of each of the newly baptized, the minister prays for each:

P: Sustain <u>Ren/Ansel</u> with the gift of your Holy Spirit: the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in your presence, both now and forever. Amen.

The presiding minister marks the sign of the cross on the forehead of each of the baptized.

P: Ansel/Ren, child of God, you have been sealed by the Holy Spirit and marked with the cross of Christ forever.

C: Amen.

CANDLE & WELCOME

P: Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will have the light of life." Let your light so shine before others that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

P: Let us welcome the newly baptized.

C: We welcome you into the body of Christ and into the mission we share: join us in giving thanks and praise to God and bearing God's creative and redeeming word to all the world.

AFFIRMATION OF BAPTISM

We are given many names in life: the things people call us and the names we call ourselves. Those names can be uplifting or they can be hurtful and degrading. In our baptism, whether as an infant or an adult, God gives each of us the name "Child of God" and claims us as God's own. It is important to be reminded of that name and what it means to be God's child and to live in God's ways. That is why we affirm, or remember and reclaim, our baptism: to be reminded of who and whose we are. Today, Confirmation students say "YES!" to their baptism.

GATHERING

P: Blessed be the holy Trinity, \pm one God, the fountain of living water, the rock who gave us birth, our light and our salvation.

C: Amen.

to serve all people, following the example of Jesus,

and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth?

Response: I do, and I ask God to help and guide me.

The leader may address others who are present.

P: People of God, do you promise to support <u>name/s</u> and pray for them in their life in Christ? **C: We do, and we ask God to help and guide us.**

Parents/sponsors are invited to come forward and stand behind their confirmand.

P: Let us pray....we give you thanks, O God, that through water and the Holy Spirit you give us new birth, cleanse us from sin, and raise us to eternal life.

The following words of blessing may be repeated for each person, while hands are placed on the confirmand.

Father in heaven, for Jesus' sake, stir up in <u>name</u> the gift of your Holy Spirit; confirm her/his faith, guide his/her life, empower her/him in his/her serving, give her/him patience in suffering, and bring him/her to everlasting life. Amen.

The pastor continues.

<u>P: Name/s</u>, we rejoice with you in the life of baptism.

C: Together, we will give thanks and praise to God and proclaim the good news to all the world.

SHARING THE PEACE

P: The peace of the Lord be with you.

C: And also with you.

P: Let us share a sign of God's peace with our neighbor.

*WORDS OF INSTITUTION
