- 4. Approve Minutes of May 27, 2025 VC meeting
 - Craig moved to approve the minutes and Cole seconded the motion. All were in favor of approving the minutes from the May 27th meeting.

5. Treasurer's Report

- Net total for the YTD is \$12,9191.43 So we are still holding steady for the year.
- Pledged was slightly above what we budgeted for the month but we are still \$8,552 under budget.
- We are ahead of budget for unpledged still by \$11,426.
- YTD to date budgeted receipts are at \$193,175.39 which is only short of the expected budgeted total(\$195,939.11) by \$2,763.72.
- The high technology cost is due to the purchase of a new computer for Christine (This included the cost of the laptop \$1228.32 + \$415 for labor).
- Under the Building Repairs and Maintenance-Other line in the detailed statement, this includes \$618.95 spent to spray for dandelions and \$1,786.47 for the roof repairs that insurance gave us a check for back in January.
- The cost for that last section insurance is covering to replace was \$18,350.13.
- One more noted expense line is the Parish Outreach line. The \$701.02 amount spent here is for another dish rack dolly and we ordered new coffee pots (4 of the 100 cups and 2 of the 50 cups).
