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12 Days of Giving How it Works

December 1-12, 2025

During Advent, we reflect on the generous love of Jesus Christ – the One who gave Himself for us. Through the 12 Days of Giving, we invite our church family to practice generosity with Jesus and like Jesus; meeting physical needs locally and globally while pointing to the true hope - Jesus Christ.

Each day there will be a prompt towards generosity, “Set Aside” means to mark it down in your finances to give that amount during your regular giving or to truly set it aside in cash and bring it to the church for our Global Outreach.

Giving Sundays

Sundays December 7 & December 14 we will have a physical donation to the Tacoma Rescue Mission and CareNet that you can bring to church. Please take a look at those Sundays ahead of time so you are prepared.

How to Donate

Each day has a section to tally your donation total. You can add each donation day together and donate in person on Sunday morning or the church office or follow the QR code listed here: Please make sure to notate that your donation is for the 12 Days of Giving.



Where does the money go?

The missionaries and missions organizations listed each day are those we support as a church through Global Outreach.

The money donated through the 12 Days of Giving will be gifted to our GO Missionaries and Missions Organizations ABOVE AND BEYOND the normal amount we support them through the GO Budget. It will be split between all missionaries and organizations equally.

Getting Started

Step 1:

Find a place in your house you can post the 12 Days of Giving Cover Page to remind you to participate each day.

Step 2:

Look over the 12 Days and decide what it looks like for your family to participate. We understand that monetary donations look different for everyone so feel free to choose as many or as few days as you're comfortable with. You can also adjust the amount you would be giving each day. We do however encourage everyone to participate by reading, reflecting and praying every day!

Please Note:

The goal is to have a heart posture of generosity; it's not about the dollar amount you are able to give!

Clean Water

Missionary: Alex & Melanie Viana

Scripture: John 7:37-38

Prompt: Set aside \$1 for every time you turn on a water faucet today.

Reflect on: How everyone needs the living water that Jesus offers.

Pray For: Alex and Melanie Viana in Mozambique; a country with a clean water score of 21.3 which is one of the lowest in the world.

Education

Organization: The Cor Deo School

Scripture: Proverbs 9:10

Prompt: Set aside 50¢ for every year you've attended school.

Reflect on: How true wisdom begins with knowing the Lord.

Pray For: As Cor Deo School comes to the Praise Covenant campus may God's glory be shown and the partnership be fruitful.

Hunger

Organization: Tacoma Rescue Mission

Scripture: John 6:35

Prompt: Set aside \$1 for every meal or snack you eat today.

Reflect on: Jesus as the Bread of Life who satisfies forever.

Pray For: The Tacoma Rescue Mission provides around 1,000 meals everyday and through that points those in need toward the Bread of Life.

Healthcare

Missionary: Vasiliy Kaletnik

Scripture: Matthew 9:35

Prompt: Set aside \$2 for every family doctor or dentist you have.

Reflect on: Jesus as the great physician.

Pray For: Vasiliy is a missionary in Moldova who helps distribute both Bibles and basic medical assistance.

5 Electricity & Light

Missionary: Aleta Loftis

Scripture: John 8:12

Prompt: Set aside 50¢ for every candle in your home.

Reflect on: Jesus as the Light of the World.

Pray For: Aleta, a missionary in a hostile country that would remove her if they knew she was leading people out of the darkness and into the light. She combats darkness every day in her work spreading Jesus' love.

6 Shelter

Missionary: Roger and Therese Koelmeyer

Scripture: Psalm 91:1-2

Prompt: Set aside \$1 for every bed and/or sleeping bag in your home.

Reflect on: God as our refuge and our shelter.

Pray For: The Koelmeyers help and oversee orphanages in Sri Lanka through KidzNet and are providing basic needs for children without homes as well as teaching them about Jesus.

7 Giving Sunday: Tacoma Rescue Mission

Action: Donate a blanket (or give \$1 per blanket in your home).

Offering: Bring all set aside funds to the church or donate online (Giving link QR Code listed in the "How it Works" section.)

Pray For: Pray for those experiencing homelessness in our city.

8 Restoration & Hope

Organization: Christian Biker Tabernacle

Scripture: Psalm 51:10

Prompt: Set aside 50¢ for every coat in your house.

Reflect on: Times God has given you hope.

Pray For: CBT provides a place and community for people pushed out of society due to mental health issues, drug addiction, criminal history, and people down on their luck.

Missionary: Steve and Elisabeth Cochrane

Scripture: Matthew 6:11

Prompt: Set aside \$1 for every egg in your refrigerator.

Reflect on: God's daily provision.

Pray For: The Cochranes work with YWAM in Southeast Asia in regions that struggle with food insecurity. They are training and discipling over 3,000 native leaders to support their communities for the Gospel.

10 Food Supply

Missionary: Cam and Kristen Caughlan

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 9:8

Prompt: Set aside \$1 for each time your family went grocery shopping this week.

Reflect on: Your current practices of generosity.

Pray For: The Caughlans use their home as a place to feed and host international students.

11 Reconciliation

Missionary: Julio and Katie Isaza

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:18

Prompt: Set aside \$2 for each phone in your home

Reflect on: God's forgiveness unto you and ways you could reconcile with others.

Pray For: The Isazas focus on reconciliation as a way of showcasing the good news of Jesus Christ building bridges in Columbia as part of the Evangelical Covenant Church.
