Church Members' Conference

Irfan Abdullatif (Light of Life, Intl) cast yet another vision for a conference that would be neither Egyptian nor Sudanese but where BOTH Baptist congregations worshipped and learned together. Bro. Irfan Abdullatif has expanded the original vision of his father and made cross-cultural mission work a reality and not just a dream.

It takes only a cursory glance at world events to see bigotry flourishing in many areas of every society. This conference shone a light and exposed the lie that cultural Christianity is necessary for stability in a local church. One dear Sudanese brother gave testimony on the final day of the conference and said, "I have been to 3-4 mixed conferences with Egyptians. As a Sudanese I always felt less and separated from the Egyptians and not as an equal believer. In this conference, all we Sudanese feel as if we are not Sudanese and they are not Egyptians but only we are all believers."

Please continue to pray for the Light of Life Baptist churches in Egypt that they may successfully partner together for the furtherance of the Gospel.
