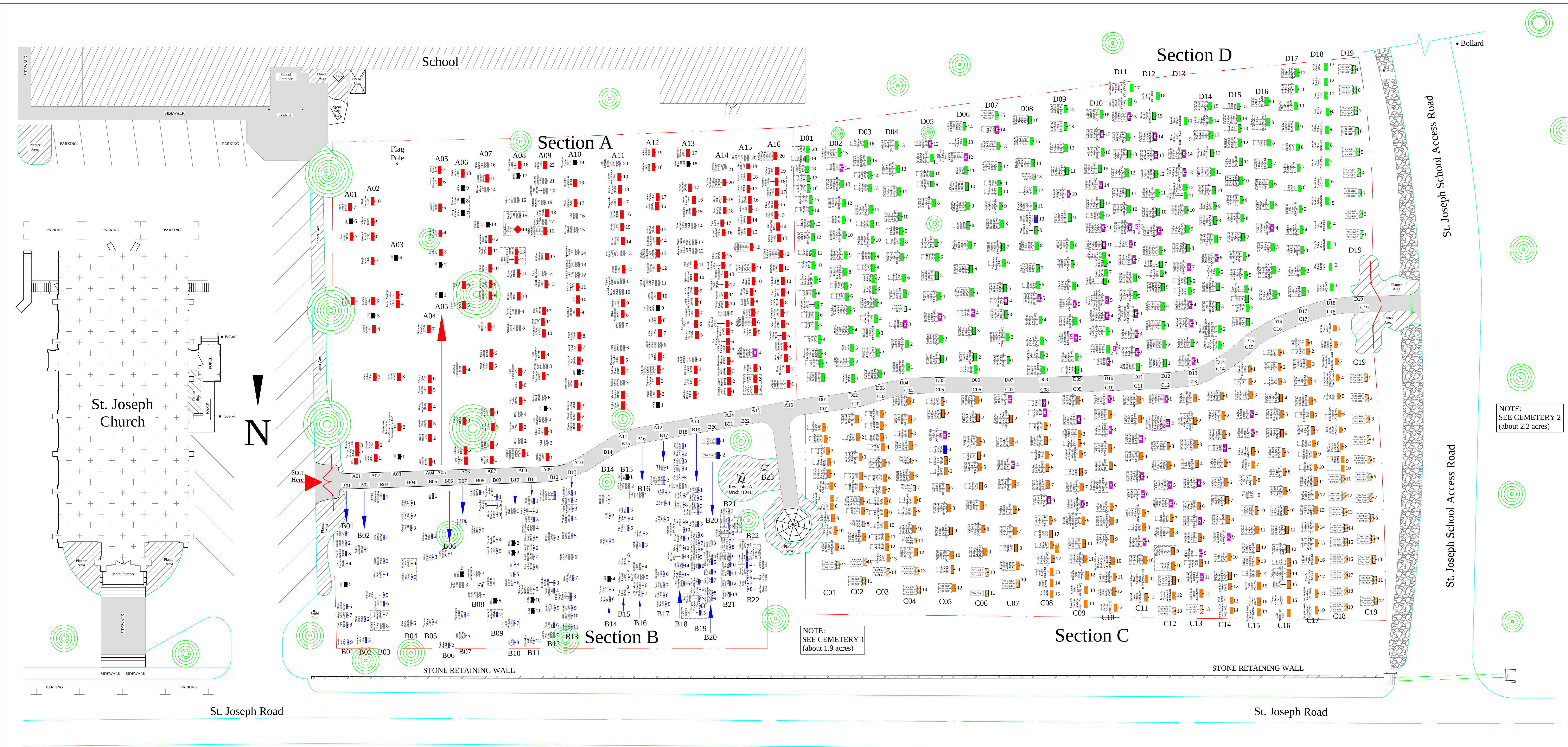




NOTE: 1. The St. Joseph Cemetery has been divided into 4 sections: A B C & D. Section A (RED) has 16 rows. Section B (BLUE) (babies and children) has 22 rows. Section C (ORANGE) & D (GREEN) currently have 19 rows.

2. B23-"Rev. John A. Ulrich's burial and gazebo area" divides the cemetery both East and West.

3. The winding sidewalk divides the cemetery both North and South.

4. Each grave stone has been identified by 'Section, Row, and Plot Number':
Examples: A0101 A1612 B0402 B2203 C0602 C1602 D0506 D1608

5. Each grave stone 'depicted on this drawing' is generically sized" for one or more persons".

DIRECTIONS:

1. Search the database for Lastname, FirstName, YearofDeath, Veteran, Section-Row Plot#, Etc. Check to see if a Spouse or 'Others' share the same Section-Row-Plot#+A, B, C, etc.

2. Read the grave stone location 'Section, Row, and Plot #' next to their name(s).

3. "Section-Row#" is posted on the winding sidewalk running East & West.

4. Study the Cemetery Map. 'Section Letter/Color', Row#, and Plot#.

Plot#'s start counting 1, 2, 3 etc. from the sidewalk 'running North or South'.

Notice: In some rows there may be burial plots for sale or plots that have been sold or "Unknown GravePlots that are difficult to see" with "Numbers"! These may or may not have a stone or a Cross.

HOWEVER, THESE NEED TO BE COUNTED, AS IF THEY WERE THERE!

NO = NOT OCCUPIED

(UK) Foundation with missing Stone, Cross or Marker. "In some cases the burial name and date may not be known".

Damaged, Broken Stone, Cross, or Marker. Some information may be known or somewhat readable.

For Couple Plots the wife's name is listed first, then the husband's; the Wife's YOD 1st, then the Husband's YOD 2nd.

WEATHERED and UNREADABLE

Note: Some stones may also be labeled with (UK); see UK notes.
