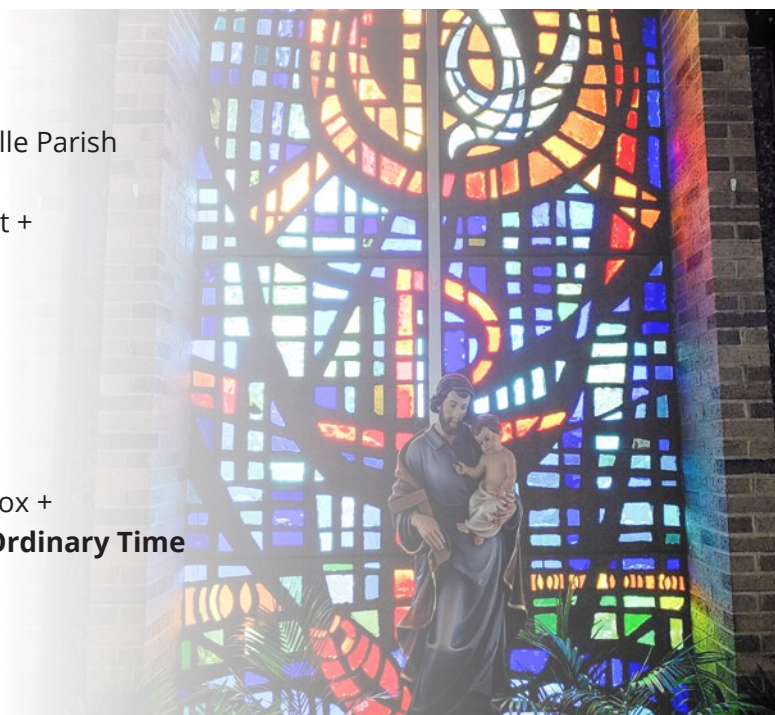

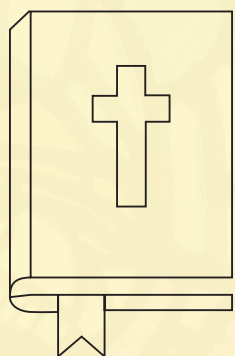

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



DIVINE PERSONAL IDENTITY

Happy Feast of the Baptism of the Lord! Jesus is growing up fast. Just last week, the Wise Men were visiting the newborn baby Jesus in the manger of Bethlehem and we fast forward this week to Jesus as a young adult being baptized in the Jordan river by John the Baptist. Why did Jesus get baptized? After all, Jesus was God and without sin...so what gives? Jesus' baptism in the Jordan by John is not for the forgiveness of sins but rather to reveal His divine identity as the "only begotten Son of the Heavenly Father." At baptism, Jesus receives confirmation of His deepest identity from God the Father, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

When you meet someone for the first time, you usually ask them what they do for a living or where they work which ends up defining their identity (Joe is a barber, Kathy is a bank teller, Steve is a nurse, etc.) Who you are is not what you do for a living or where you work or how much money you make or what car you drive, who you are is a beloved son or daughter of a loving heavenly Father. You have a divine identity – God says to you today, "I love you, with you I am well pleased!"

I am certain that long before Jesus hears the words from Heaven confirming His divine identity, He hears the words, "I love you" from his mother Mary and foster father Joseph. Jesus' earthly parents help Him to form His divine identity as a beloved son. This week, when you introduce yourself to someone, tell them you are a beloved son or daughter of God the Father. Tell someone you love that you love them and remind them that God loves them most of all!

PARISH NEWS



This can be a tough time of year! When I say I am from South Dakota, many people assume that I am used to colder temperatures. While they are mostly correct, I was not prepared for the lack of sunlight here in Cleveland. I remember a priest told me once that despite February being the shortest month of the year, it always feels like the longest. It is not February yet, but I tend to agree with his sentiment – low temperatures, minimal sunlight, and higher rates of illness can make winter very difficult. These factors can also lead to increased stress, restlessness, anxiety, depression, and solitude. In these times, it is important to maintain our self-care. In the past, we have discussed viewing self-care through the lens of “re-creare” which means to “re-create.” In the winter, what recreates our motivation, energy, and love for others? One difficulty is that this process can become more difficult in the winter. Exercising outside is difficult, visiting friends is often interrupted by weather or illness, and less sunlight tends to impact our mood. With these things in mind, it is important to make recreation more of a priority and to brainstorm strategies that are possibly outside of our normal routine. Engaging in board games, finding ways to exercise indoors, and taking up a new indoor hobby (just to name a few) are all strategies that I have encountered in my work that people find helpful. Although it may be difficult, if you find yourself struggling this time of year, consider revisiting how you recreate to find new ways of finding peace and wellness despite the cold weather. – Luke Brown

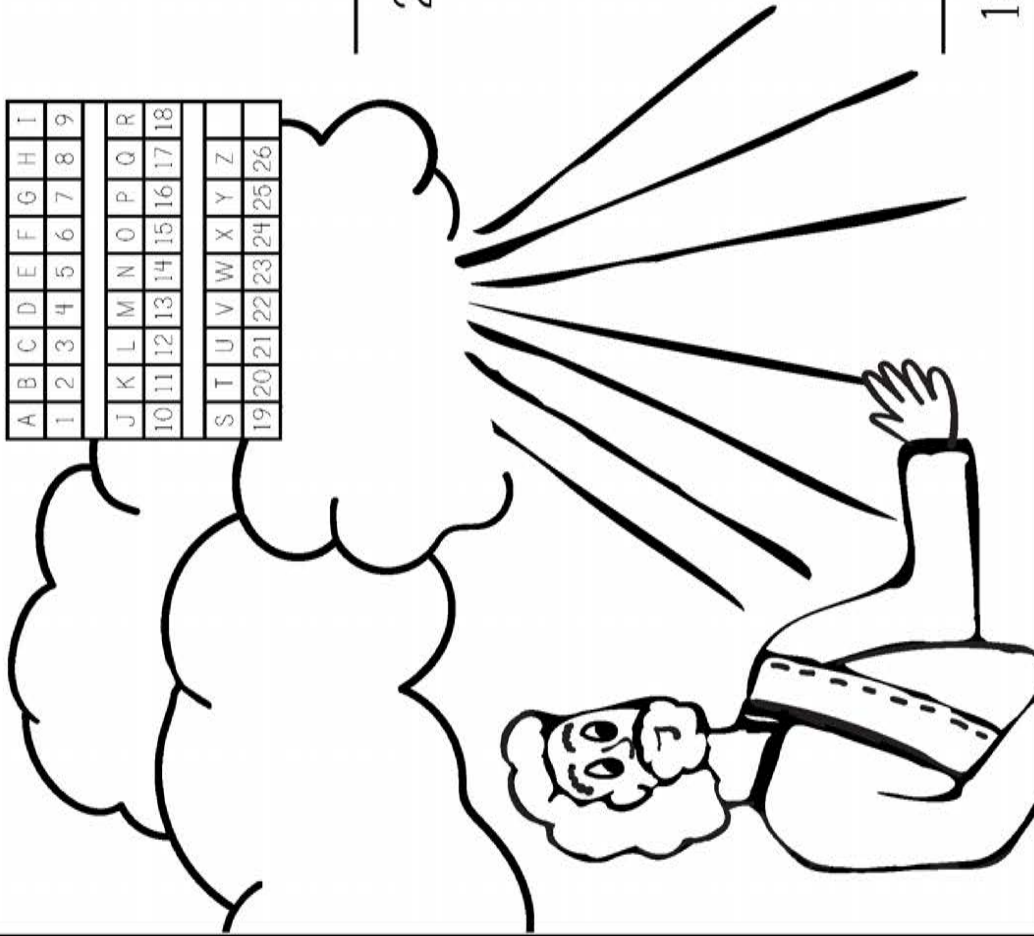
