





LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



SAINT ANTHONY OF THE DESERT, PRAY FOR US!

When most people think of Saint Anthony, they think of Saint Anthony of Padua, the person they pray to for help in finding their lost car keys or some other misplaced object. However, Anthony of Padua is not the only Saint Anthony in the history of the Church. On Saturday, January 17th, the Church celebrates another very holy man named Anthony – Saint Anthony the Abbot or Saint Anthony of the Desert.

Saint Anthony was born in Egypt around AD 251 to a rather wealthy landowning family near Cairo. He was born into an empire, that while officially pagan and often engaged in violent persecutions of Christians, nonetheless saw the faith spreading throughout the empire. During his lifetime, he would see the Church go from being persecuted, to being accepted with the legalization of religious toleration in AD 313 by Emperor Constantine. Around the age of 18, Anthony lost both of his parents and inherited their several hundred acres of land, as well as responsibility for his younger sister. This dramatic change in his life prompted him to do a great deal of reflection, and through a personal encounter with the Word of God, the course of his life was changed.

One day while at Mass, Saint Anthony heard the words of Matthew's Gospel: "If you wish to be perfect, go, sell your possessions, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." He said that these words struck him as if God Himself were speaking directly to him and so heeded their meaning. Anthony went out and sold all that he had and gave away his possessions and money to the poor, keeping only what was needed to take care of his sister and see to her education. From here he initially went to live among the tombs, and then eventually out into the desert, in order to become a hermit (these were individuals who went out into deserted places in order to withdraw from society and live a life of asceticism, wholly dedicated to Christ through prayer and penance). Saint Anthony would spend about the next 14 years living in seclusion in the desert and surviving off the charity of others. There he would battle all sorts of temptations and diabolical attacks (the devil would appear to him in horrid and grotesque forms) to leave his chosen path to holiness, but he remained resolute, following the advice he would later give to those who came to learn to live as he did: "Believe me; the devil fears the vigils of pious souls, and their fasting, their voluntary poverty, their loving compassion, their humility, but most of all, their ardent love of Christ our Lord. As soon as he sees the sign of the Cross, he flees in terror."

Around the age of 33, Anthony's asceticism had taken a toll on his health and he was found in a serious condition. He was taken to a nearby church to heal, and after his recovery, he moved to a mountain near the Nile River and took up residence in an abandoned fort, once again adopting the ascetic life of a hermit. His reputation for holiness spread and began to attract those who sought his advice or who wanted his intercession, as miraculous healings were attributed to his intercession. There were also those who wanted to imitate him, who began to establish their own hermitages in the wilderness around him. It was at this time that Anthony felt the call to become a spiritual father (abbot) to these fellow hermits and so he would emerge from his solitude in order to offer them guidance on cultivating virtue and living a life of holiness. This move marked the beginning of monasticism. Saint Anthony would live out the rest of his life in this way, returning to society for a brief time to combat the Arian heresy, but then going back to the wilderness until his death at the age of 105. Throughout the history of the Church, there are numerous men and women who share the same name who are canonized Saints. Anthony is only one such example. Maybe there is already a Saint with your name; that doesn't mean that there isn't room for you also to become a Saint.

KNIGHTS WITH CHRIST COMING SOON!

Last year in Bishop Malesic's pastoral letter entitled, "A Flourishing Apostolic Church," he outlined that the clear mission for every parish is to worship, serve, and evangelize. At St. Columbkille, our mission is to Worship God, Serve Others, and Grow Disciples of Jesus (Evangelize). In the spirit of continuing to grow disciples of Jesus in 2026, we are adding a new series of four events with the purpose of encountering Jesus' Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist. Our first Knight with Christ is on Sunday, January 25th from 7-9 PM in the church. Each night, we will hear a hopeful and inspiring Catholic message, spend time in Eucharist Adoration with an opportunity for Confession, and end the evening with fellowship and food. If you know anyone who is a fallen away Catholic or someone who is a spiritual seeker looking to come back to God, please invite them to one of these great Knights with Christ! See further details in this weekend's bulletin.





