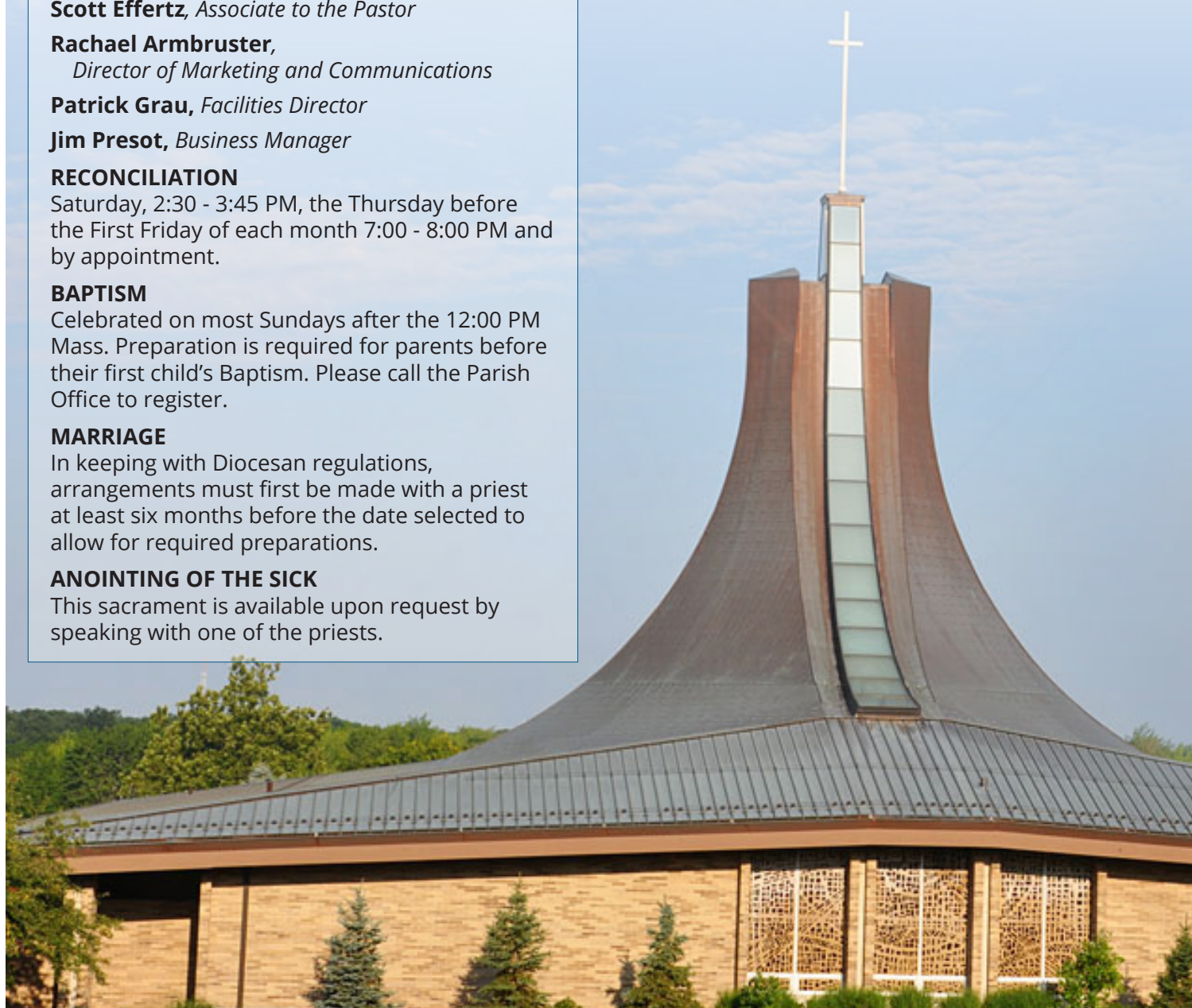

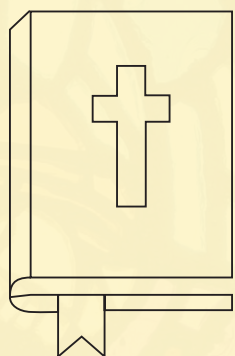

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



ST. FRANCIS DE SALES PRAY FOR US!

Have you ever said to yourself: I wish I were holier, or knew how to pray better, or knew what I needed to do to deepen my spiritual life? If this sounds familiar, then the man we celebrate on January 24th is someone to whom you should pay careful attention. Saint Francis de Sales was born in AD 1567, in Savoy, France, and lived during the turbulent times following the Protestant Reformation. Francis' father had great plans for his son, and so sent him to study in Paris and then Padua, hoping that one day he would hold a great political office.

Despite Francis' inclination that God might be calling him to the priesthood (something he was aware of for thirteen years), he did as his father wished, and earned a doctorate in law. Upon returning home from his studies, he was offered a political post, but refused it, and instead disclosed to his family that he wanted to become a priest. His father was very strongly opposed to the idea, and only after significant persuasion did he finally give his blessing.

After being ordained a priest, Francis found himself filled with zeal to bring souls back into Christ's Church. Just over the mountains from where he was serving was a Calvinist stronghold, and so he decided to lead a mission to win them back (an idea that many regarded as crazy). For three years, he traveled through Calvinist Switzerland having doors slammed in his face, having rocks thrown at him, being forced at times to sleep in trees so as to avoid wolves, facing death threats, and even having his feet frostbitten so badly that they bled in the snow as he tromped through it.

Initially, he met with no success, as no one would even talk with him. So, he began to copy his sermons and slip them under people's doors. He also reached out to the children of the towns that he visited, and when the parents saw how kind he was to their children, they began to talk to him. By the time Saint Francis returned home, through his writing and preaching, he had brought over 40,000 souls back into communion with the Catholic Church.

At the age of 35, Saint Francis became the Bishop of Geneva, where he continued to labor with great intensity, not only to win more converts back to the Catholic faith, but also to catechize and form the people placed under his charge. He served as a spiritual director for countless persons, offering direction both in person and in writing. This was revolutionary, as the commonly accepted notion at the time was that holiness was only for priests and nuns, but Francis upheld that all people were called by God to a life of holiness. He authored numerous works including *Introduction of the Devout Life*, where he explained in a very practical terms how to live a holy life in the midst of the world. Saint Francis de Sales died in AD 1622. He was canonized in AD 1665, and in AD 1887, was declared a doctor of the Church.

In the *Introduction to the Devout Life*, Francis tells us that "devotion must be practiced in different ways by the nobleman and by the working man; by the servant and by the prince; by the widow, by the unmarried girl, and by the married woman. But even this distinction is not sufficient; for the practice of devotion must be adapted to the strength, to the occupation, and to the duties of each one in particular... [is it] proper for a bishop to want to lead a solitary life like a Carthusian; or for people to be no more concerned than a Capuchin about increasing their income; or for a working man to spend his whole day in Church like a religious...?"

Saint Francis reminds us that while we are all called to holiness, this call must be adapted according to our state in life. And so, if you find that you don't have the prayer life of a monk, that's ok, you're not supposed to (unless, of course, you are a monk). Each of us must have a prayer life adapted to the life to which God has called us. Everyone is called to prayer and service, but not everyone is called to prayer and service in exactly the same way. How is the Lord inviting you to prayer and service this week? Never forget, the Lord is with us, always!

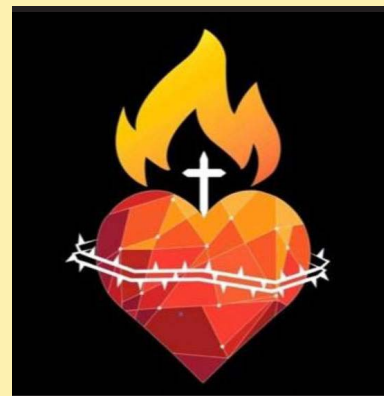
In this weekend's Gospel, we hear the story of Peter and Andrew being called by Jesus. Something that I think we overlook in this Gospel passage is what Peter and Andrew left behind when they followed Christ. When they left their boats behind, it is easy to look at what they left behind as being insignificant. Having a boat in modern times is, generally speaking, a hobby. In the context of this Gospel passage, boats were more than just a hobby. Peter and Andrew were leaving behind their entire livelihood and investment in their career. Boats were very hard to make and very expensive. When we realize the sacrifice that Peter and Andrew made, we see the gravity of what we are called to do when we choose to follow Christ. Following Christ is no small matter and does not come without

significant sacrifice. However, we know from our faith that significant sacrifice is very much worth it for the promise of Heaven and the closeness with God. There is nothing in this life that is worth more than our relationship with God and the promise of Heaven. Just as Peter and Andrew sacrificed their livelihood and investment to pursue God, we need to sacrifice anything that comes between us and God. This is no easy journey and we all have things that are difficult to sacrifice. If you find that there are things in your life coming between you and God, consider reflecting on the lives of Peter and Andrew and what it takes to become a follower of Christ. - Luke Brown
