



LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



HAPPY FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY!

Three Wise Men, New Year's House Blessing! The Christmas Season continues this weekend with the Feast of the Epiphany: Wise Men bringing gifts to Jesus. Every year, we sing a popular Christmas song about three kings and the gifts they brought to the Christ Child. The song is not technically correct, because the Bible does not say they were kings.

Matthew 2:1-2 says, "Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came Wise Men from the East to Jerusalem, saying, 'Where is the newborn King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the east, and have come to worship Him.'" Matthew 2:11 continues, "And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary His mother, and fell down, and worshipped Him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto Him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh." So why is the Epiphany and the Wise Men so special for Catholics?

Epiphany marks the occasion of a time-honored Catholic tradition of "chalking the doors." The formula for the ritual — adapted for 2026 — is simple: Take chalk of any color and write the following above the entrance of your home: 20 + C + M + B + 26.

The letters have two meanings. First, they represent the initials of the Wise Men or Magi — Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar — who came to visit Jesus in His first home. They also abbreviate the Latin phrase, *Christus mansionem benedicat*: "May Christ bless this house." The "+" signs represent the cross, and the "20" at the beginning and the "26" at the end mark the year. Taken together, this inscription is performed as a request for Christ to bless those homes so marked and that He stay with those who dwell therein throughout the entire year.

The chalking of the doors is a centuries-old practice throughout the world, though it appears to be somewhat less well-known in the United States. It is, however, an easy tradition to adopt, and a great practice whereby we dedicate our year to God from its very outset, asking His blessing on our homes and on all who live, work or visit them there.

Most often, the chalking takes place after Epiphany Mass, and can be done at any church, home, workplace or school. Traditionally, the blessing is done by either a priest or member of the family. This blessing can be performed simply by just writing the inscription and offering a short prayer, or more elaborately, including songs, prayers, processions, the burning of incense, and the sprinkling of holy water.

After all the Epiphany Masses this weekend, packets of blessed chalk, prayers, and containers of Epiphany holy water (holy water blessed with special blessings for Epiphany) are being distributed. Any member of your household or family can pray the prayers, follow the ritual and write the blessing on the doors of your home.

KNIGHTS WITH CHRIST COMING SOON!

Last year in Bishop Malesic's pastoral letter entitled, "A Flourishing Apostolic Church," he outlined that the clear mission for every parish is to worship, serve, and evangelize. At St. Columbkille, our mission is to Worship God, Serve Others, and Grow Disciples of Jesus (Evangelize). In the spirit of continuing to grow disciples of Jesus in 2026, we are adding a new series of four events with the purpose of encountering Jesus' Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist. Our first Knight with Christ is on Sunday, January 25th from 7-9 PM in the church. Each night, we will hear a hopeful and inspiring Catholic message, spend time in Eucharist Adoration with an opportunity for Confession, and end the evening with fellowship and food. If you know anyone who is a fallen away Catholic or someone who is a spiritual seeker looking to come back to God, please invite them to one of these great Knights with Christ! See further details in this weekend's bulletin.



PARISH NEWS



As a counselor, you would not believe how many times I hear about New Year's Resolutions. They are most frequently made about things like diet, exercise, and saving money, but the possibilities are endless. I find myself having very little faith in New Year's Resolutions alone to actually change anything in a person's life. While there are exceptions, I have found that most people start building up January 1st as a big transformative day months in advance, find the courage to stop or start their behavior resolution, and then inevitably slip up, crash and burn, and refrain from trying again until next year. A friend I have in the gym business says that January 1st is the biggest day of the year for new memberships, followed by a sharp decline in attendance throughout the rest of the month. My issue with these resolutions is that failure is very common and having this significant start date for a resolution just leads to increased self-loathing, disappointment, and despair. Who cares if you fail on January 7th? Now the new start date is January 7th – start again. You went 7 days without eating Oreos! Excellent! Now try for 10 days. One of the most important virtues is hope, and Christ wants us to remember this virtue when we fall. We need to always have hope for ourselves and continuously get up to try again when we fall. The real failure and despair come from quitting altogether. This week, consider praying about your goals for self-improvement and remember that the process is a lifelong journey with Christ.

Begin the new year studying the first book of the Bible. So many of the people we will meet in this book: Adam, Eve, Abraham Noah, Isaac, Rachel, Sarah, just to mention a few, are so familiar to us. 


