



LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

The Committee will be looking at:

- ★ Mass schedules to ensure there are daily Masses available, and at various times, to enable Eucharist celebration for all.
- → The Sacrament of Reconciliation and the option of designating a certain time a month where multiple confessors would come to a given church.
- ♣ Offering accessible times for Adoration and prayer before our Lord in the Fucharist.

We will be considering various ministries to collaborate, share resources and incorporate best practices. Spiritual development through worthy worship and accessible opportunities to celebrate the sacraments is vital for our growth.

The Bishop has asked how best we can get the message of Jesus and his Gospel into our communities, to our parishioners and potential parishioners. He encourages the faithful to spend at least 15 minutes daily in prayer, to celebrate the sacraments and to serve those in need.

As Bishop Malesic outlined in his Pastoral Letter, the people of God are the front-line workers for Christ in our society. These efforts require all of us to live in such a way that when others encounter us, they encounter Christ.

As we begin this process, we ask for your prayers. The committee members welcome your ideas and words of encouragement as we work to build and strengthen a community of faithful people who love and serve the Lord.

We will provide updates as we progress. Our goal is to foster a deanery that worships together and cares for one another.

"For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted." This verse has always struck me as powerful, yet it is also easy to misunderstand. In my work with couples, I stress the importance of developing insight into one's own flaws, insecurities, and wounds. Without self-awareness, cultivating humility is nearly impossible, and without humility, a marriage struggles to thrive. Humility in marriage doesn't mean thinking poorly of ourselves or diminishing our worth. Rather, it means being honest with ourselves before God—acknowledging where we fall short, where we wound others, and

where we need grace. This honesty allows us to receive God's mercy and extend that mercy to our spouse. The Pharisee in the parable shows the danger of self-comparison, focusing on what he does better than others. This false sense of righteousness blocks him from seeing his own need for grace. The tax collector, by contrast, recognizes his weakness, admits his sin, and keeps his eyes on God. His humility opens him to receive mercy. In marriage, the same truth applies. When we lack self-awareness, we are quick to point out our spouse's faults and slow to acknowledge our own. This leads to cycles of pride, defensiveness, and hurt. But when we approach our spouse with humility, we recognize our own brokenness and need for God's forgiveness, making it easier to extend grace to our spouse. True humility is not merely self-awareness or self-criticism; it is a posture of the heart that allows us to see both our need for God and our spouse's need for grace. We can't achieve this on our own; it is only through God's grace and our surrender to Him that we grow in humility and learn to love our spouse more faithfully, gently, and fully. - Luke Brown
