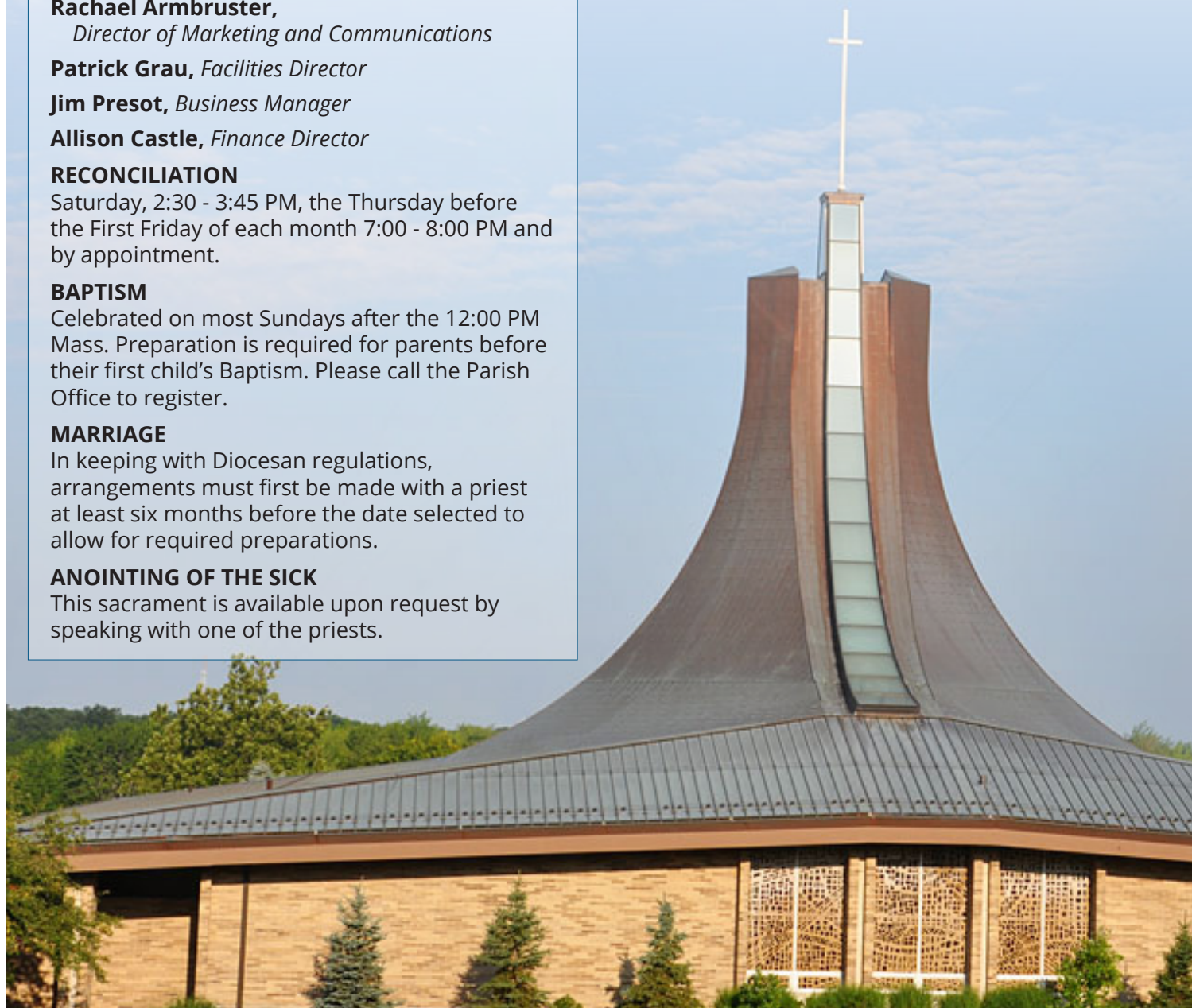

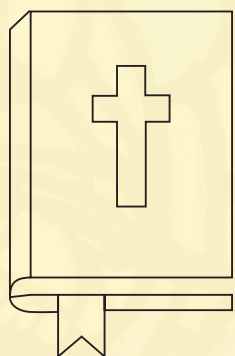

## LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



### HAPPY FEAST OF JESUS CHRIST, THE KING OF THE UNIVERSE!

On this final weekend of the Church's liturgical year, we boldly exclaim Jesus Christ as the King of the universe. We read in Sacred Scripture "the Lord is King forever and ever (Psalm 10:16). O Lord, our Sovereign, how majestic is your name in all the earth (Psalm 8:1, 9)!" God is Creator and Ruler, sovereign Lord and King forever! If this is true, then we do not have to fear, deny, or disengage from the world. If this is true, then Jesus' reign extends over science and art, work and play, leisure and culture, hearts and hands, politics, neighborhoods, and nations.

### ANGEL SCHOLARSHIP FUND TO HELP OUR SCHOOL!

You can help our school make tuition even more affordable for our families using a State of Ohio tax credit. Ohioans can now receive a 100% tax credit of up to \$750 (\$1,500 for married couples filing jointly) for donations to the Angel Scholarship Fund. Best of all, it is completely free! It is very easy to apply. I did it in just five minutes from my computer.

Simply review your tax liability form from the State of Ohio from last year (Form 1040 IT, line 8c) to help you estimate the amount of your tax liability for this year against which the credit can be taken. Make your contribution online at [www.catholiccommunity.org/angel](http://www.catholiccommunity.org/angel), or by calling 216-902-1312. **Make sure you list St. Columbkille School on the application form so our kids can benefit from the donation.**

**Contributions must be made by December 31st, 2025 for St. Columbkille to use the money next school year and by April 15, 2026 to be eligible for a tax credit in 2024.** Use the tax receipt that you receive from the Angel Scholarship Fund to claim your tax credit when you file your State of Ohio income tax return. You will receive all the money you donated back from the State of Ohio with your tax refund next year! ### CELEBRATE OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

On Friday, December 12th, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the Pro-Life Group of St. Columbkille invites you to join in celebrating Our Queen and Mother as Patroness of the Americas and of the Unborn. The image has special significance during the Advent season because Mary is depicted as pregnant with Jesus.

Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared in Mexico as the pregnant Mother of God to Blessed Juan Diego, an Aztec Indian, on December 9th, 10th, and 12th, 1531. She left a Miraculous Image of her appearance on his cactus fiber cloak, or tilma, which still exists today for all to see in the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City. Our Lady came to offer faith, hope and consolation to the oppressed natives of Mexico and to reconcile them with their Spanish rulers. She put an end to the bloody human sacrifice of the Aztecs and converted 10 million natives in 10 years!

Her miraculous image, left on Juan Diego's coarse tilma was responsible for the conversion of 8,000,000 Indians. According to Kodak of Mexico, the image is smooth and feels like a modern-day photograph. Several images can be seen reflected in the eyes of the Virgin and the distortion and place of the images are identical to what is produced in the normal eye. The image, to this date, cannot be explained by science. It shows no sign of deterioration after 450 years! (The fibers used to make the tilma usually disintegrate in 15-30 years.) The stars on her mantle are the constellation that appeared in the sky that day. Our Lady promised to eradicate abortion in our land by converting all who look upon her image.

Do you feel called to pray to our Lady in a more intimate way? Consider inviting her into your home this year! ## PARISH NEWS



How often we doubt. Doubt is one of the key tools the devil uses in his bag of trickery. When doubt creeps in, it creates a small crack—an opening for the evil one to enter. I see this often among couples who are struggling in their marriages. Trust, one of the main pillars of any relationship, becomes shaken and distorted when doubt takes hold. Faith and trust cannot be separated; where faith falters, trust weakens as well. In this week's Gospel, we see the bystanders questioning Jesus—who He is, His intentions, His identity, even His divinity. They seek to understand something that can only be known through faith. We

were not made for this world, and divine understanding is impossible without trust and faith in God. It is only through Him that true understanding comes. The man who needed no sign but simply placed his faith in Jesus was the one who was saved: "You will be with me today in paradise." He asked for nothing more than for Jesus to remember him. In that humble request, he professed his faith in Christ as the Son of God. Trust in relationships often comes down to a simple question: Can I rely on you? One man beside Jesus condemned Him, while the other relied on Him completely. When trust is broken between couples, it's as though a window has been left cracked open—leaving the home vulnerable to outside influences that can separate us from Christ, and ultimately from one another. As trust erodes, we begin to demand proof of love where we once rested securely in it: "If you loved me, you would..." Men and women are different—and for good reason. In many ways, these differences are how the Sacrament of Marriage purifies and sanctifies us together. But it can be easy to lose sight of that. We begin to see the very differences we once cherished as problems to be solved. When we return to faith and trust—both in God and in one another—we begin to see more clearly. Love, after all, was never meant to be proven; it was meant to be lived. - Luke Brown

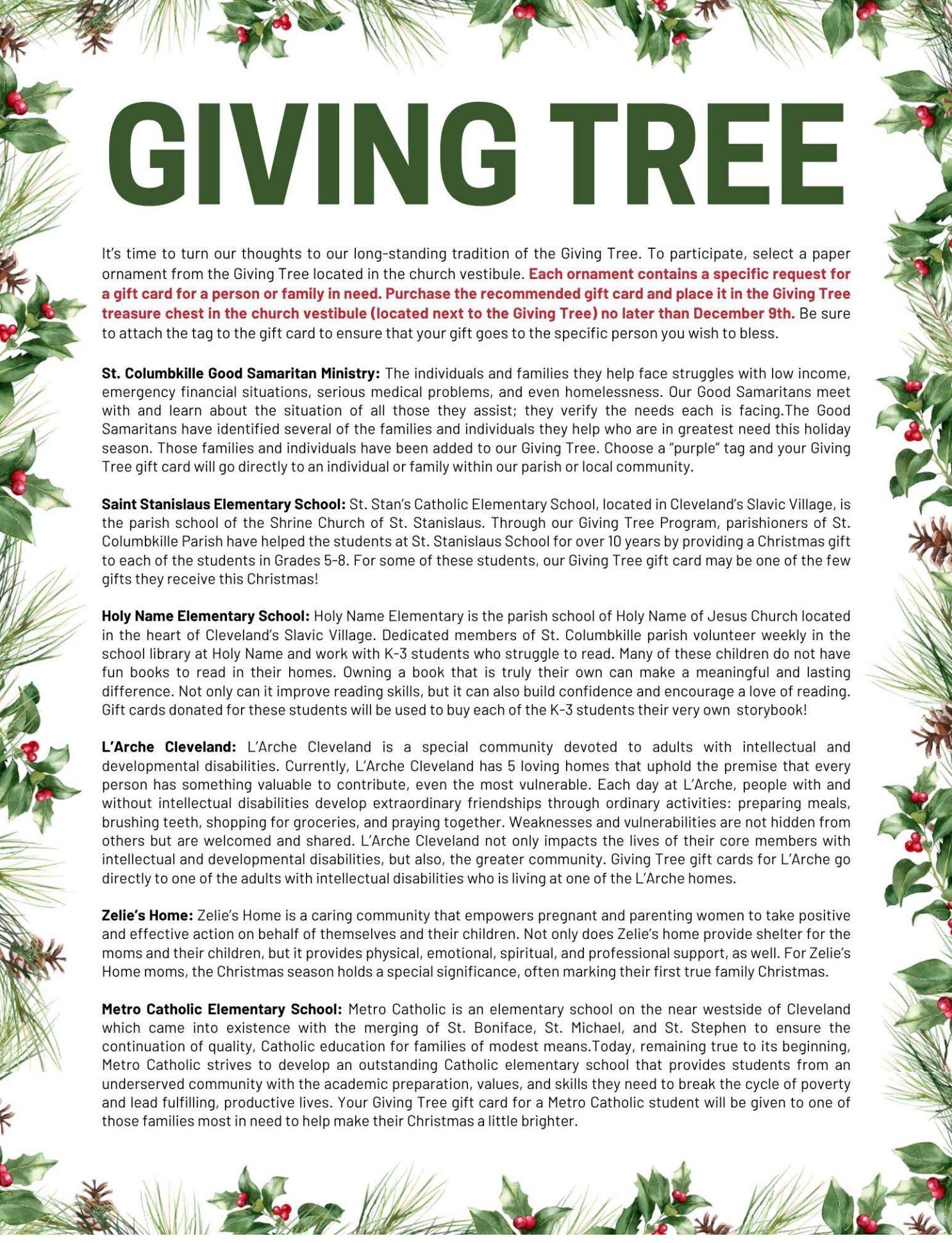

# GIVING TREE

It's time to turn our thoughts to our long-standing tradition of the Giving Tree. To participate, select a paper ornament from the Giving Tree located in the church vestibule. **Each ornament contains a specific request for a gift card for a person or family in need. Purchase the recommended gift card and place it in the Giving Tree treasure chest in the church vestibule (located next to the Giving Tree) no later than December 9th.** Be sure to attach the tag to the gift card to ensure that your gift goes to the specific person you wish to bless.

**St. Columbille Good Samaritan Ministry:** The individuals and families they help face struggles with low income, emergency financial situations, serious medical problems, and even homelessness. Our Good Samaritans meet with and learn about the situation of all those they assist; they verify the needs each is facing. The Good Samaritans have identified several of the families and individuals they help who are in greatest need this holiday season. Those families and individuals have been added to our Giving Tree. Choose a "purple" tag and your Giving Tree gift card will go directly to an individual or family within our parish or local community.

**Saint Stanislaus Elementary School:** St. Stan's Catholic Elementary School, located in Cleveland's Slavic Village, is the parish school of the Shrine Church of St. Stanislaus. Through our Giving Tree Program, parishioners of St. Columbille Parish have helped the students at St. Stanislaus School for over 10 years by providing a Christmas gift to each of the students in Grades 5-8. For some of these students, our Giving Tree gift card may be one of the few gifts they receive this Christmas!

**Holy Name Elementary School:** Holy Name Elementary is the parish school of Holy Name of Jesus Church located in the heart of Cleveland's Slavic Village. Dedicated members of St. Columbille parish volunteer weekly in the school library at Holy Name and work with K-3 students who struggle to read. Many of these children do not have fun books to read in their homes. Owning a book that is truly their own can make a meaningful and lasting difference. Not only can it improve reading skills, but it can also build confidence and encourage a love of reading. Gift cards donated for these students will be used to buy each of the K-3 students their very own storybook!

**L'Arche Cleveland:** L'Arche Cleveland is a special community devoted to adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Currently, L'Arche Cleveland has 5 loving homes that uphold the premise that every person has something valuable to contribute, even the most vulnerable. Each day at L'Arche, people with and without intellectual disabilities develop extraordinary friendships through ordinary activities: preparing meals, brushing teeth, shopping for groceries, and praying together. Weaknesses and vulnerabilities are not hidden from others but are welcomed and shared. L'Arche Cleveland not only impacts the lives of their core members with intellectual and developmental disabilities, but also, the greater community. Giving Tree gift cards for L'Arche go directly to one of the adults with intellectual disabilities who is living at one of the L'Arche homes.

**Zelie's Home:** Zelie's Home is a caring community that empowers pregnant and parenting women to take positive and effective action on behalf of themselves and their children. Not only does Zelie's home provide shelter for the moms and their children, but it provides physical, emotional, spiritual, and professional support, as well. For Zelie's Home moms, the Christmas season holds a special significance, often marking their first true family Christmas.

**Metro Catholic Elementary School:** Metro Catholic is an elementary school on the near westside of Cleveland which came into existence with the merging of St. Boniface, St. Michael, and St. Stephen to ensure the continuation of quality, Catholic education for families of modest means. Today, remaining true to its beginning, Metro Catholic strives to develop an outstanding Catholic elementary school that provides students from an underserved community with the academic preparation, values, and skills they need to break the cycle of poverty and lead fulfilling, productive lives. # BOX OF JOY

Materials will be available beginning **November 1st**, and the deadline for returning your packed Box of Joy gifts is **November 25th**.

**1) Get a Box** Pick up your box at the Welcome Desk in church beginning November 1. A brochure with instructions and gift ideas is included. Boxes are available at the parish office during normal business hours, as well.

**2) Shop** Go shopping and personally select gifts to bring joy to a child – gifts such as small toys, school supplies and other treasured items. No liquids, foods or combat-related items.

**3) Fill the Box** Pack the gifts you have purchased in the Box provided. Items may be removed from their original packaging to fit everything in your box. Be sure to mark the gender and age of the child you are gifting in the space provided.

**4) Return the Box** Place your filled Box of Joy under the Giving Tree in the church vestibule (or return to school or parish office). The deadline for returning your filled Box of Joy is November 25th.

Can you find all the instruments in this picture? There is an organ, a harp, and a guitar!





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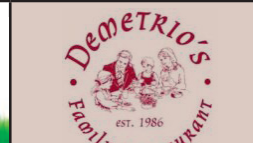
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
