

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



HAPPY 4TH SUNDAY OF ADVENT – JESUS' BIRTH CHANGES US!

When Joseph learns Mary is pregnant before they were married, his faith is tested. Joseph is about to divorce Mary quietly and walk away when the Angel Gabriel appears to him in a dream to renew his faith, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son, and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." Joseph's faith is tested because God is working in extraordinary ways to bring salvation to humanity.

If the Holy Family faced struggles and trials along the way to giving birth to the Messiah, why do you doubt that you may have to face problems as well? It is easy to forget that Joseph's "yes" to

the angel to trust his wife Mary was not a business transaction; it took lots of courage, patience, and perseverance. It is easy to focus on that final image of the Holy Family, but creating that family was hard work. Thank you for putting in the work to face the challenges of daily life and trust that Emmanuel, God is with us!

DEAR PARENTS OF YOUNG CHILDREN AT MASS

You are doing something important and essential by bringing your kids to Mass every week. You are making good on the promises made at your child's Baptism! I know it's not easy. I know you come to church already exhausted. Parenting can be tiring. I watch you bounce, sway, cringe, whisper, give "the look," and sometimes have to exit. You wonder, "Is all this worth it?" because you sometimes leave Mass more fatigued than fulfilled. Never forget that what you are doing is so important, so keep it up!

When you are here with your children in tow, our church is filled with a joyful noise! When you are here, the Body of Christ is fully present, young and old. Your presence with your kids reminds us that worship is about coming together; where all are welcome – where we share God's Word and Eucharist as one. And when you are here, I am filled with hope that our pews will not be empty...one day soon, your babies and toddlers will receive Communion from our altar...one day soon, your little ones will be Confirmed here...one day your kids will be married or serve as a priest at St. Columbkille; all because you brought them to Mass. Your young children are learning now, before it is too late – learning by your example that worship of God is important.

I see them soaking it all in. In the midst of cries, whines, tears and giggles, they still know: to share a Sign of Peace; to fold their little hands in prayer; to bow to the Eucharist; to say "Amen" and "Thanks be to God." I see them learning and yearning to connect with God. You need to know that it matters. It matters to me...it matters to other parents and children...it matters to the whole assembly that families care about their faith. Most of all, it matters to God, and it matters to those little lives you are molding.

Thank you for bringing your children to Mass! Your family is a vital part of our St. Columbkille parish family – with all its noise, struggle and joy. We love you; we love seeing you here, keeping coming!

Simply review your tax liability form from the State of Ohio from last year (Form 1040 IT, line 8c) to help you estimate the amount of your tax liability for this year against which the credit can be taken. LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Make sure you list St. Columbkille School on the application form so our kids can benefit from the donation. Contributions must be made by December 31st, 2025 for St. Columbkille to use the money next school year and by April 15, 2026 to be eligible for a tax credit in 2025. Use the tax receipt that you receive from the Angel Scholarship Fund to claim your tax credit when you file your State of Ohio income tax return. You will receive all the money you donated back from the State of Ohio with your tax refund next year! See the Welcome Desk for copies of the forms for more information.



Are we aware of how many times we shut down and block the action of love (whether from God or others) in our lives? In our Responsorial Psalm this weekend, we read that we should "let the Lord enter." In this season of Advent, we are encouraged to make ready our hearts for the coming of Jesus. Yet this preparation requires our willingness to open ourselves up and feel safe doing so. If we cannot do this with God, it is unlikely we will be able to with others. Putting up a wall and not letting anyone trustworthy in may not be readily apparent; perhaps this is because the last time we allowed someone in they hurt

us. Unfortunately, the cost of shutting down is significant and often leads to emotional isolation, disconnection, and ultimately, loneliness. People we care about can be so near to us in proximity, yet seem so far from knowing who we really are. Joseph had to allow himself to be convinced that it was safe to take Mary and her baby into his home. We need to be like St. Joseph; we need to allow ourselves to be convinced that it is safe to be known and loved by God and others. We can start by first acknowledging – then knocking down – the walls we have erected. Come, Emmanuel! - Luke Brown


