



## LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



### **HAPPY SEASON OF LENT!**

Lent is a 40-day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that began on Ash Wednesday (February 18th) and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday (April 2nd). It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord Jesus' Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the Waters of Baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ. Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season.

In addition, the giving of alms is one way to share God's gifts—not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents. As St. John Chrysostom reminds us: "Not to enable the poor to share in our goods is to steal from them and deprive them of life. The goods we possess are not ours, but theirs." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2446). In Lent, all the baptized are called to renew their baptismal commitment as others prepare to be baptized through the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, a period of learning and discernment for individuals who have declared their desire to become fully initiated Catholics. Let's spend some time examining the reason why the Church wants every Christian to fast during the Lenten Season. Please pick up a copy of the double-sided Lenten handout at the Welcome Desk with all the extra Lenten opportunities to grow in faith together and prepare for the celebration of Jesus' Resurrection at Easter!

### **LATIN MASS RESPONSES DURING LENT!**

Beginning this weekend for the 1st Sunday of Lent, we will be singing the Holy, Holy, Holy (Sanctus), Memorial Acclamation (Post Consecrationem), Lamb of God (Agnus Dei) and the Great Amen in Latin. If you want to follow along, the words will be on the screens and can also be found in the Breaking Bread Hymnals beginning with number 839.

### **LENTEN OPPORTUNITIES FOR SPIRITUAL GROWTH!**

After our Lenten Fish Frys, Fr. Suso or Fr. Spicer will be praying the Stations of the Cross every Friday of Lent at 7 PM in Church. In addition to praying the Stations, one of our priests will be hearing Confessions from 7-8 PM every Friday of Lent. Booklets for the Stations and handouts on the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be provided. Please stop by the church and pray this ancient devotion to get ready for Jesus' Resurrection at Easter.

Our Southwest Suburban Deanery is going to be hosting an entire week of celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation during the Season of Lent. See the full-page ad in this weekend's bulletin for details on where and when you can go to Confession during the Lenten season. On Wednesday, March 4th from 5-8 PM, every priest in every Catholic Church throughout our eight-county diocese will be celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Both Fr. Spicer and I will be available for Confession during this time. If you know someone who has been away from church for a long time, please reach out to them and invite them to come.

### **ENCOUNTER SCHOOL OF MINISTRY PARISH MISSION COMING SOON**

Are you looking for healing and a spiritual boost during this Lenten season? Do you want to see the Holy Spirit bring life and renewal to our church?
