



LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



HAPPY SEASON OF LENT!

Lent is a 40-day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that began on Ash Wednesday (February 18th) and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday (April 2nd). It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord Jesus' Resurrection at Easter. Lent is an important time for Catholics to remember your deepest divine identity as beloved sons and daughters of a good and loving God. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the Waters of Baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's

death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ. Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season.

In addition, the giving of alms is one way to share God's gifts—not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents. As St. John Chrysostom reminds us: "Not to enable the poor to share in our goods is to steal from them and deprive them of life. The goods we possess are not ours, but theirs." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2446). In Lent, all the baptized are called to renew their baptismal commitment as others prepare to be baptized through the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, a period of learning and discernment for individuals who have declared their desire to become fully initiated Catholics. Let's spend some time examining the reason why the Church wants every Christian to fast during the Lenten Season. Please pick up a copy of the double-sided Lenten handout at the Welcome Desk with all the extra Lenten opportunities to grow in faith together and prepare for the celebration of Jesus' Resurrection at Easter!






