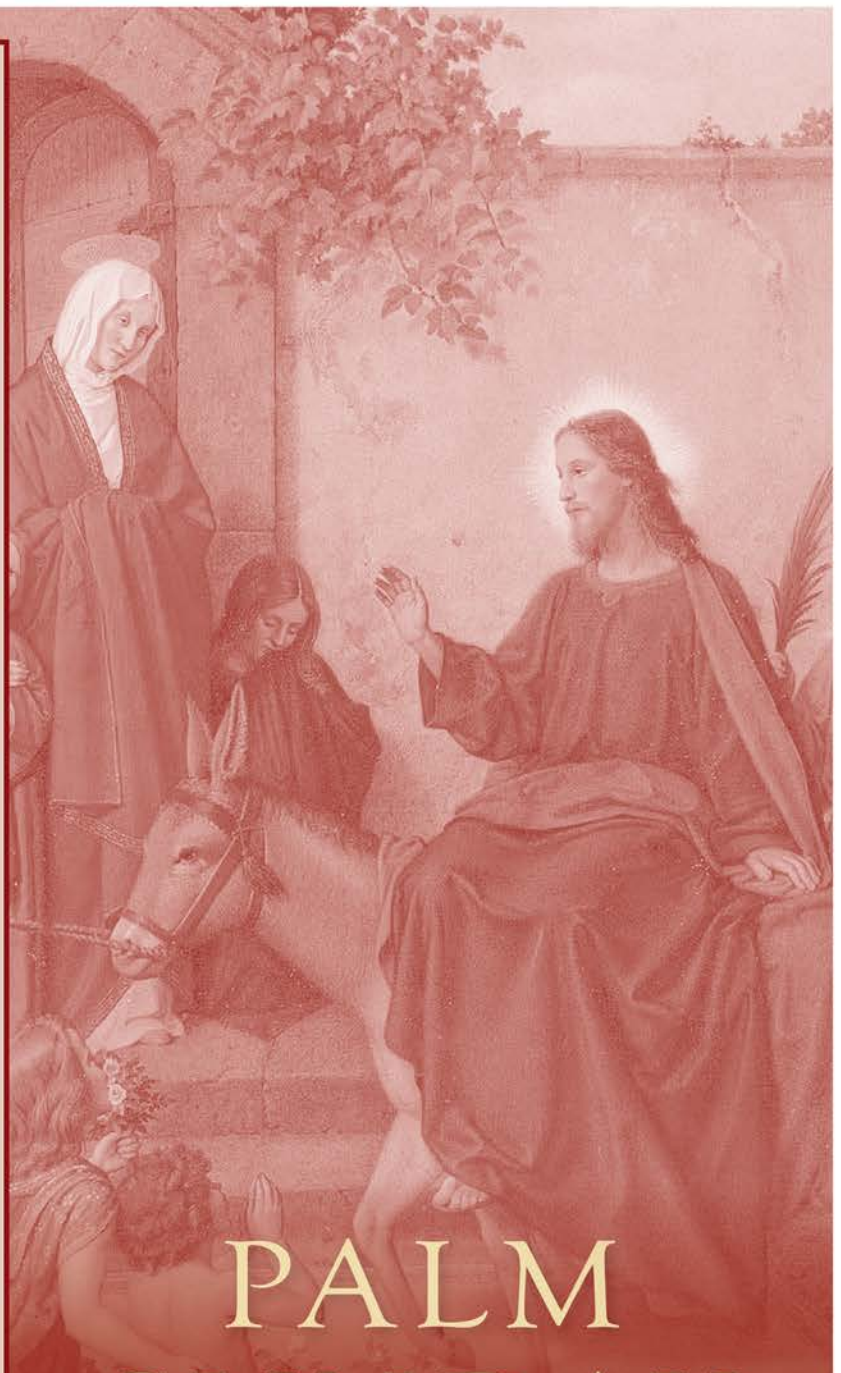

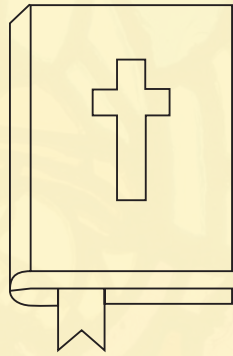

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



HOLY WEEK BEGINS WITH PALM SUNDAY!

Today begins the greatest week in human history: Holy Week starts with Palm Sunday – Jesus’ triumphant entry into the City of Jerusalem – preparing to die for our sins. “The tragedy of the passion brings to fulfillment our own life and the whole of human history. We can’t let Holy Week be just a kind of commemoration. It means contemplating the mystery of Jesus Christ as something which continues to work in our souls.” –Saint Josemaria Escriva

This week, Jesus knocks at the gates of our souls. What will our reaction be? Will we set all things aside to be with our Savior? In committed and silent prayer, invite Jesus to speak while we listen. Let us prepare our hearts to hear by surrendering our worries, anxieties, and family into God’s hands. With a quiet mind and silent home, I invite you to become aware of Jesus’ voice in your life.

This Sunday’s readings remind us that Jesus is not just one god amongst many, nor is He merely the new King David. Jesus shares a name with the unspeakably Holy One who reigns from eternity, uncontested and immeasurably glorious. This same God embraced not only a painful death, but also an immensely shameful one. Crucifixion was used on bad slaves and horrible criminals. Symbolically, crucifixion meant that THIS MAN did not deserve citizenship, was not trusted to own property, could not even direct his own life, and finally, was a bad slave. Jesus accepted what was given Him: an absolutely humiliating death.

He accepted this because He knew and loved His Heavenly Father. He accepted this because He knew and loved you and me. Jesus sought His comfort in God alone. God seeks us this Holy Week. Journey with Him to the cross by meditating and reflecting on the Palm Sunday Gospel. Receive what the Lord seeks to share with you in prayer. Give Him an open heart, an open mind, and open ears. May this Holy Week invite you into a more intimate encounter with God. May you, like Jesus, seek comfort in God.

Will we trust a God-Man who trusts His Father so perfectly? What might Jesus bring into our home? Crosses? Glory? Humility? Love? Whatever Jesus brings, remember the great gift of Himself that He gives us and His promise to be with us always.

“O souls! Seek refuge, like pure doves, in the shadow of the crucifix. There, mourn the Passion of your Divine Spouse, and drawing from your hearts flames of love and rivers of tears, make of them a precious balm with which to anoint the wounds of your Savior.” – Saint Paul of the Cross

It is Palm Sunday! I pray that all of you have had a grace-filled Lent and find yourselves closer to the Lord through sacrifice and prayer. Speaking of prayer, this week I wanted to discuss silence. In today's world, silence is undervalued and sometimes hard to find. I am just as guilty of this, but we have endless entertainment in our pocket at all times. This creeps into every place we used to have boredom and silence – waiting rooms, car trips, even walking on the sidewalk. As our world becomes more and more inundated with technology, accessibility, and immediate gratification, the amount of silence in our lives shrinks. I believe this is one of the reasons anxiety has increased so much in the last 20 years. Fear of missing out, constant availability via smartphone, and never-ending entertainment at our fingertips are just a few things that have become a part of daily life for most people. If you do not have any silence in your life, I would encourage you to try a few different things. Driving with the radio off is a good way to start. Maybe try praying in a quiet part of your house and leave your phone in a different part of the house where you cannot hear it buzzing or beeping. If we do not take time for silence and we are constantly distracted, we lose our connection with God and with ourselves. It is often in the silence that we come to know God and ourselves. Consider making time for silence so that you can be better prepared to take in all that God has in store for you as we celebrate the Paschal Mystery. – Luke Brown

14 developmentally disabled adults living in L'Arche Cleveland homes

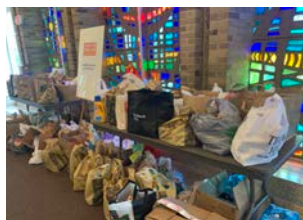
45 families in need at Metro Catholic Elementary School

DECEMBER, JANUARY, AND FEBRUARY MEAL MINISTRY VOLUNTEERS

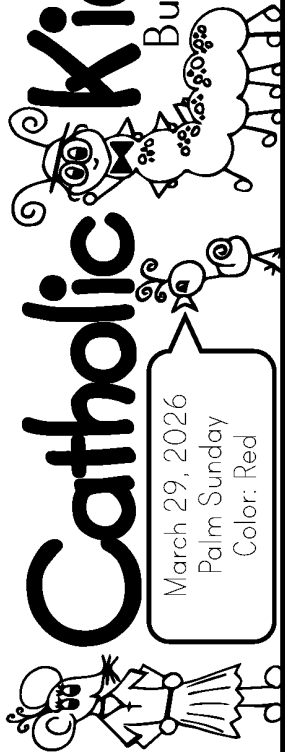

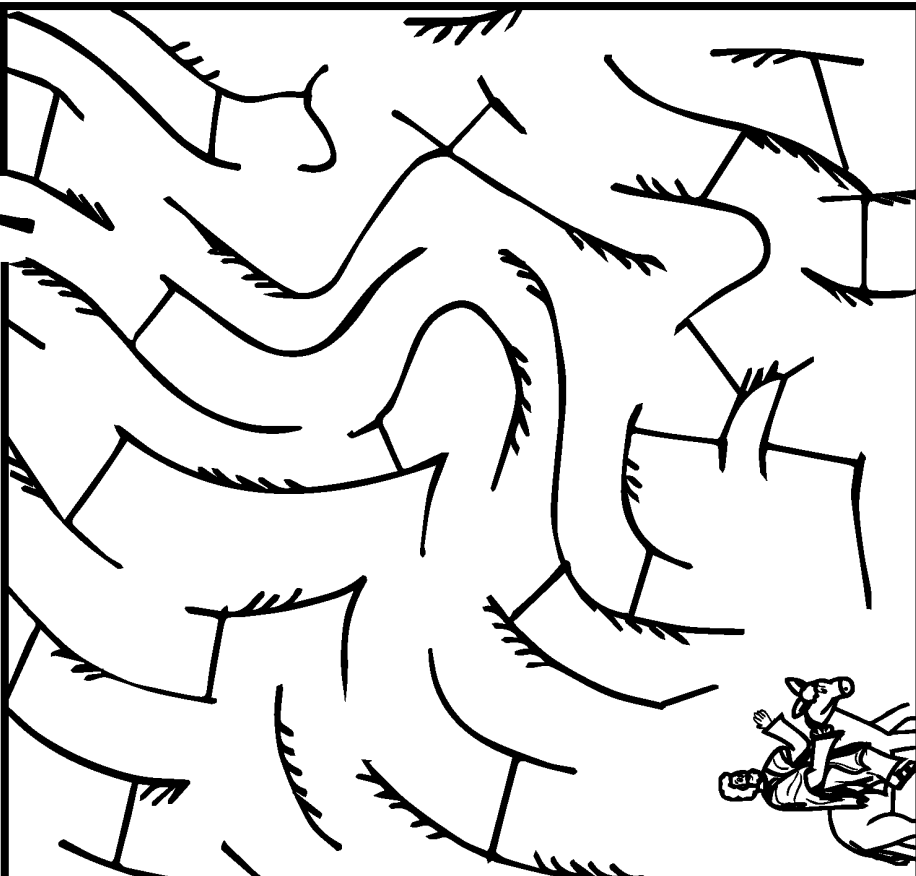

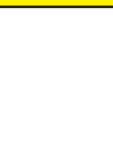
