



## LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



### UPDATE ON PARISH/SCHOOL FACILITIES MASTER PLANNING!

Over the next three years, every Catholic parish in the Diocese of Cleveland will be participating in a capital campaign to raise funds to help support critical diocesan ministries. I am happy to announce that Bishop Malesic has given our parish permission to conduct a combined capital campaign to begin later this year. At St. Columbkille, we will be raising additional funds to supplement our invested monies to help us renovate and beautify our worship space, build a perpetual Eucharistic Adoration Chapel, provide ADA accessibility to meeting spaces in our church basement, renovate our parish offices, construct a new rectory house for our priests, and important renovations to our school HVAC systems including adding air conditioning to our school building. Our parish facilities team, finance council and parish council have all been assisting me and my staff in evaluating some of the initial improvements and designs. Right now, we have a budget of \$10 million dollars for the renovation projects, and we are prepared to use \$7-\$8 million dollars of our invested monies and raise additional funds for the completion of the projects.

The Catholic Diocese has partnered with CCS, a fundraising company to assist us in evaluating how much money we can successfully raise in a pledge campaign over the period of five years. We are working closely with the Moody Nolan Architecture firm along with Marous Brothers Construction for pre-construction estimates and drawings which we hope to share with you all in the coming months. After Easter, a representative from CCS fundraising will be conducting a feasibility study with our parish to assist us in estimating how much money we can successfully raise. Stay tuned for further updates and details to come after Easter.

### KNIGHTS WITH CHRIST COMING SOON!

Last year in Bishop Malesic's pastoral letter entitled, "A Flourishing Apostolic Church," he outlined the clear mission for every parish is to worship, serve, and evangelize. At St. Columbkille, our mission is to Worship God, Serve Others, and Grow Disciples of Jesus (Evangelize). In the spirit of continuing to grow disciples of Jesus in 2026, we are adding a new series of four events with the purpose of encountering Jesus' Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist. The Holy Eucharist is the armor we need to wear in our world. Our first Knight with Christ is on Sunday, March 15th from 7-9 PM in the church, sponsored by our Walking with Purpose Women's ministry. Each night, we will hear a hopeful and inspiring Catholic message, spend time in Eucharistic Adoration with an opportunity for Confession, and end the evening with fellowship and food. If you know anyone who is a fallen away Catholic or someone who is a spiritual seeker looking to come back to God, please invite them to one of these great Knights with Christ!

### PALM SUNDAY AND HOLY WEEK ARE COMING SOON!

Rejoice because we've made it to the middle point of Lent...Easter joy is around the corner! Rejoice because God's mercy is greater than your sin. Spring weather has finally arrived, and Holy Week is just three weeks away. Here is a brief outline of all the Holy Week opportunities for prayer and encounter with our Risen Lord:

Palm Sunday is March 29th, and we will be commemorating Jesus' entry into Jerusalem with the Blessing and Distribution of Palms at all the Masses. On Monday, March 30th, Fr. Spicer and Fr. Suso will be hearing Holy Week Confessions at 1 PM and 7 PM in church. On Tuesday, March 31st, all the priests of our diocese will be gathering at St. Sebastian Parish in Akron with Bishop Malesic for the annual Chrism Mass where our holy oils for the new year will be blessed and all the priests will renew the promises of Holy Orders at a special Mass open to the faithful at 5 PM. On Wednesday, April 1st, Fr. Suso and Fr. Spicer will be hearing Holy Week Confessions in church.

On Holy Thursday, April 2nd, we will have Morning Prayer at 8:15 AM in church followed by the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:30 PM commemorating Jesus' institution of the Holy Eucharist at the Last Supper. Night Prayer will be prayed in church at 10:30 PM on Holy Thursday. On Good Friday, April 3rd, we will have Morning Prayer at 8:15 AM in church followed by the Passion of our Lord Service at 3 PM and finally Stations of the Cross at 7 PM. On Holy Saturday, April 4th, we will have Morning Prayer at 8:15 AM in church followed by two Easter basket food blessings at 11:30 AM and 12:30 PM. The Great Easter Vigil Mass will be at 8:45 PM in church. **Please note there are no 2:30 PM Confessions or 4 PM Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday.** On Easter Sunday, April 5th, we have Easter Masses at 8 AM, 10 AM, and 12 PM. **Parish Offices are Closed on Good Friday, April 3rd and Easter Monday, April 6th so our staff can pray with us and their families on Easter. The Holy Eucharist will be reposed in our Perpetual Adoration Chapel beginning at 9 AM on Holy Thursday, April 2nd and remain closed until 9 AM on Monday, April 6th for the Sacred Paschal Triduum.**

Never forget, the Lord is with us, always!

# ST. JOSEPH'S TABLE SERVICE SATURDAY MARCH 21ST

St. Joseph's Table is a beautiful tradition rooted in gratitude and charity. Join us as we gather in prayer, share a meal, and give thanks for God's many blessings. In the spirit of St. Joseph, we will also share with those in need within our community.

## TRADITION

We proudly continue the tradition of Saint Joseph's Table, a custom that originated in Sicily, Italy in the Middle Ages. Legend has it that during a severe drought, the Sicilians prayed to Saint Joseph, their patron saint and the protector of Jesus, for relief from the drought. When the rains came, the people rejoiced! In gratitude, they prepared a special table with an assortment of food from their harvest. These tables, or "altars," offered cookies and cakes, breads, fruit, fava beans, and beautiful decorations of candles, figurines, and flowers. After paying homage to Saint Joseph, the food was shared by all then distributed to those less fortunate. The celebration of Saint Joseph's Table was born, and is now celebrated annually all around the world, on or near March 19th, Saint Joseph's feast day.



**Attend:** Come share a meal and fellowship with our community.

**Bake:** Bake home-made foods / bakery to display on the table: breads, pastries, anything that does not require heat or refrigeration. After our celebration, any remaining foods will be packed and given to those in need.

**Donate:** If you prefer not to bake, bring a non-perishable food item to assist in our parish's efforts to feed the poor. See the parish website for a list of especially needed items.

**Menu:** Immediately following the opening prayer and blessing, a delicious luncheon will be provided, free of charge, by our Meal Ministry. Bean soup, St. Joseph's Day pasta, and of course, breads, and desserts.




