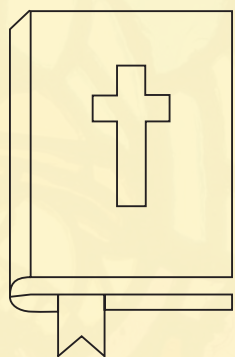

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



BISHOP MALESIC IS TRANSFERRING FR. SPICER TO HOLY FAMILY IN PARMA!

Last week, I received the news that Fr. Spicer's four-year parish assignment as our parochial vicar at St. Columbkille is coming to an end on June 9th. Bishop Malesic is transferring Fr. Spicer to be the next parochial vicar at Holy Family in Parma. Fr. Spicer will be replacing Fr. Joe Spolny at Holy Family who is retiring from active ministry in June. Fr. Spicer's last weekend at St. Columbkille will be June 6th-7th; June 7th happens to be our parish feast day picnic.
