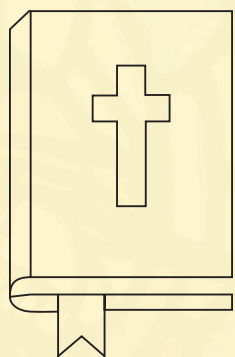

## CALLED TO FLOURISH: OUR CHURCH FOR THE FUTURE CAMPAIGN!

Last week, I received a letter of approval from Bishop Malesic allowing our parish to pursue a combined capital campaign for the master planning and renovation of our church and school campus. This is a tremendous blessing for our parish and will allow us to provide much needed improvements to our facilities in the coming years. Right now, we are conducting a feasibility study with the help of CCS Fundraising, our diocesan campaign partner, to determine how much money we can reasonably raise over a five-year pledge period. Thank you to the initial wave of parish and school families who scheduled Zoom interviews with CCS. Thank you as well to our facilities planning team for your guidance and feedback on the preliminary designs. You all are providing us with valuable information we need to move forward. Everyone is going to have the opportunity to provide feedback on the renovation plans and have the chance to contribute by your prayers and generous monetary gifts to the campaign. We hope to have the results of the feasibility study by the middle of June to share with the parish. Stay tuned to the bulletin for further updates.

## SACRAMENTALITY, EUCHARIST, AND DIVINIZATION: FOUNDATION FOR THE MYSTICAL LIFE

For 25 years, Bishop Michael G. Woost has taught sacramental and liturgical theology at the seminary. On May 9, 2022, he was called by Pope Francis to become the Auxiliary Bishop of the Diocese of Cleveland. He was ordained as a Bishop on August 4, 2022, in the Cathedral of Saint John the Evangelist by Bishop Malesic. He was named a member of the USCCB's Committee on Divine Worship in 2022 and Chairman-Elect of that Committee in November 2024. Bishop Michael has directed retreats and workshops on contemplative prayer and the Church's mystical tradition, as well as on the Church's liturgy and sacramental life.



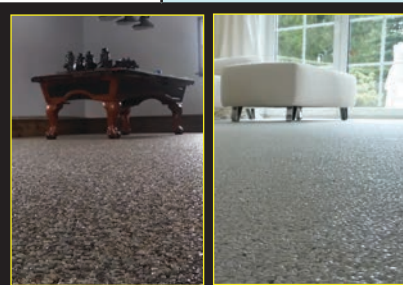
