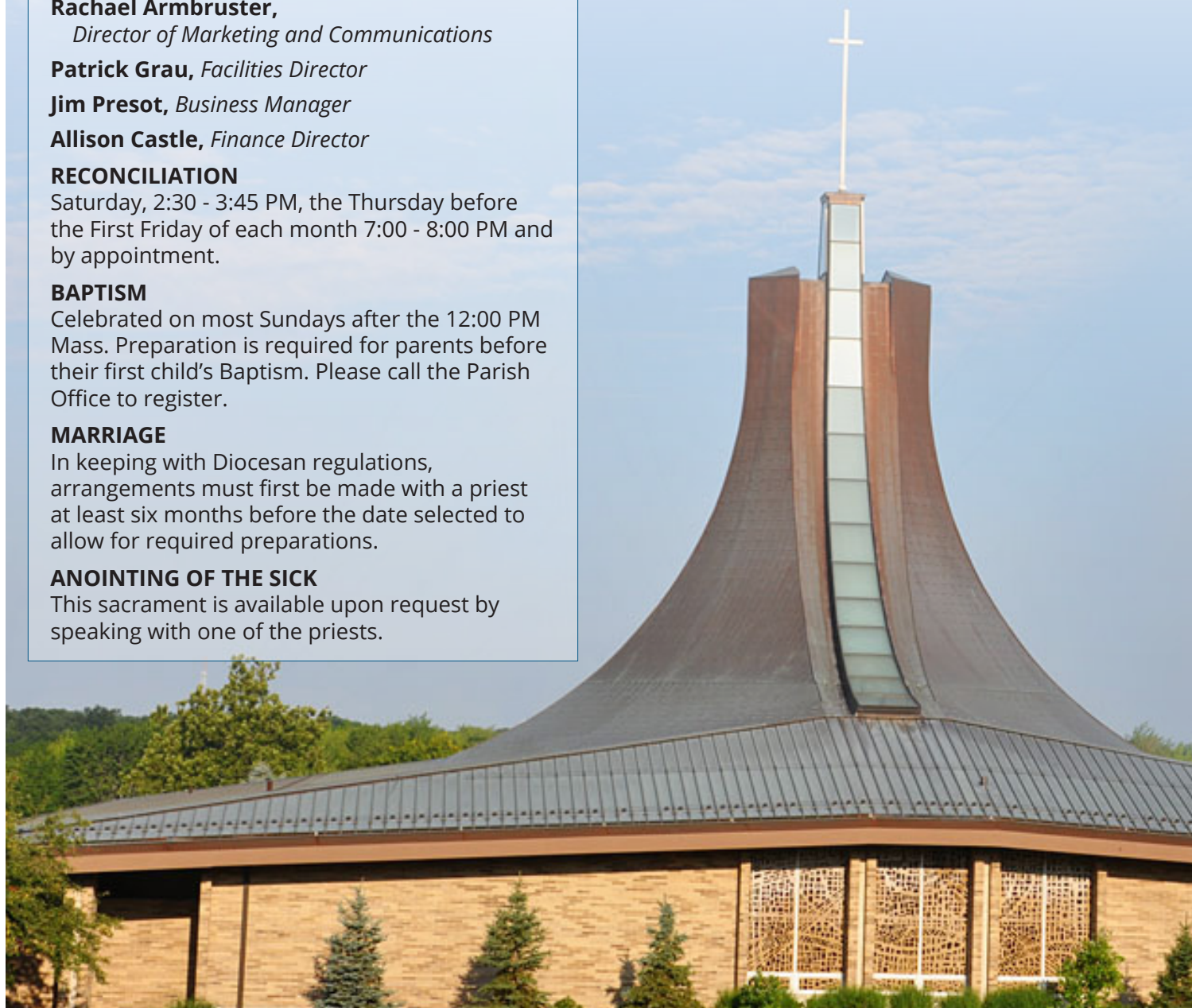

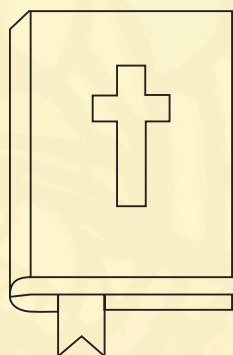

# LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



## HAPPY FATHER'S DAY!

Today, we recognize the fathers of our families and thank them for their service and care for us. We also encourage them because, in this day, good husbands and fathers aren't appreciated by society. Often, people think of a father as someone who provides for his family. This is true but, more importantly, a father protects his family from danger and guides them to spiritual maturity. Consider St. Joseph, husband of Mary, foster father of Jesus. Not a word Joseph spoke is recorded, but his actions are. Joseph was a man of deep faith and was obedient to God, so when the angel told him to overcome fear and take Mary as wife, he did (Mt 1:20-25). Joseph was observant of religion and obedient to God (Lk 2:21-24). Joseph protected his family from dangers of the state (Mt 2:13-15). Joseph taught his children to work and pray (Mt 13:55, Lk 4:16). Many forget about Joseph's work in the Gospel, but Jesus' early life and formation as a man sprang from Joseph's fatherhood.

Our society needs such husbands and fathers more than ever. Study after study shows that children grow best in a family with a father and mother. The nuclear family of a faithful father and mother with children is inspired by the community of the Holy Trinity. The Christian family models for us the exchange of love found in God. The Christian understanding of God as father is first modeled by earthly fathers. A prime example can be found in the life of Karol Wojtyla—the future Holy Father, Pope John Paul II. He lost his mother at 9 years of age and then spent much of his time with his father; they even shared the same bedroom at night. Young Karol recalls waking up in the early hours, way before dawn, and seeing the figure of his father kneeling, deeply absorbed in prayer. This example of his father left an indelible impression on the young Karol. His earthly Father had a deep and intimate relationship to God the Father and transmitted this to his son. Then Karol would become the great "Holy Father"—Pope John Paul II, one of the greatest and clearest reflections of true fatherhood in the history of the world.

This week, join me in praying for all our fathers. Some of us may have lost our father or not even known our father. Regardless of our circumstances, we all have a heavenly Father who loves us, who offered His only Son for the forgiveness of our sins. May God bless all our fathers.

## PALLOTTINE FATHERS MISSION APPEAL!

Please welcome Fr. Stephen Mutie, SAC, who will be visiting our parish to share the missionary work of the Pallottine Fathers in Tanzania, Kenya, and Uganda. A special collection will be taken to support their ministries of evangelization, education, healthcare, and care for the most vulnerable. The Pallottine Fathers were founded in Rome in 1835 by a priest of the Diocese of Rome. Fr. Stephen Mutie was ordained to the priesthood in 2018 and has served in missionary ministries in both Tanzania and Kenya. He currently serves as Associate Pastor of St. Vincent Pallotti Parish in Wyandotte, Michigan, and as a Hospital Chaplain at Henry Ford Wyandotte Hospital. He looks forward to sharing his missionary experiences and the challenges and joys of proclaiming the Gospel in East Africa.

- Building and equipping elementary schools in rural communities in Tanzania and Kenya, providing children with access to quality education and a brighter future.
- Supporting the Siuyu Rehabilitation Centre in Tanzania, a ministry that provides education, therapy, healthcare, and hope to children living with physical and intellectual disabilities.
- Educating and forming seminarians, helping prepare future priests who will serve the Church in East Africa for generations to come.

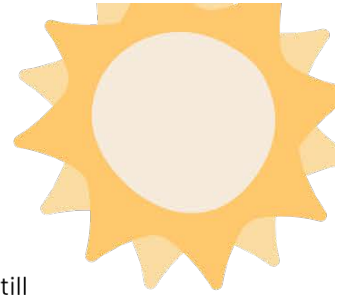

### FALL SPORTS REGISTRATION – now through June 30<sup>th</sup>

Fall sports are registering now so teams can be formed and practices start at the end of July. Registration is now open to students in 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade. Participation is open to 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders at St. Columbkille School/PSR students or a current, active parishioner at St. Columbkille parish. Registering after June 30<sup>th</sup> adds a late fee of \$20. Registration after the late registration deadline of July 7, 2026 will result in the student athlete being placed on a waiting list and does not guarantee a spot on the team.

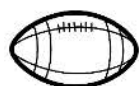
