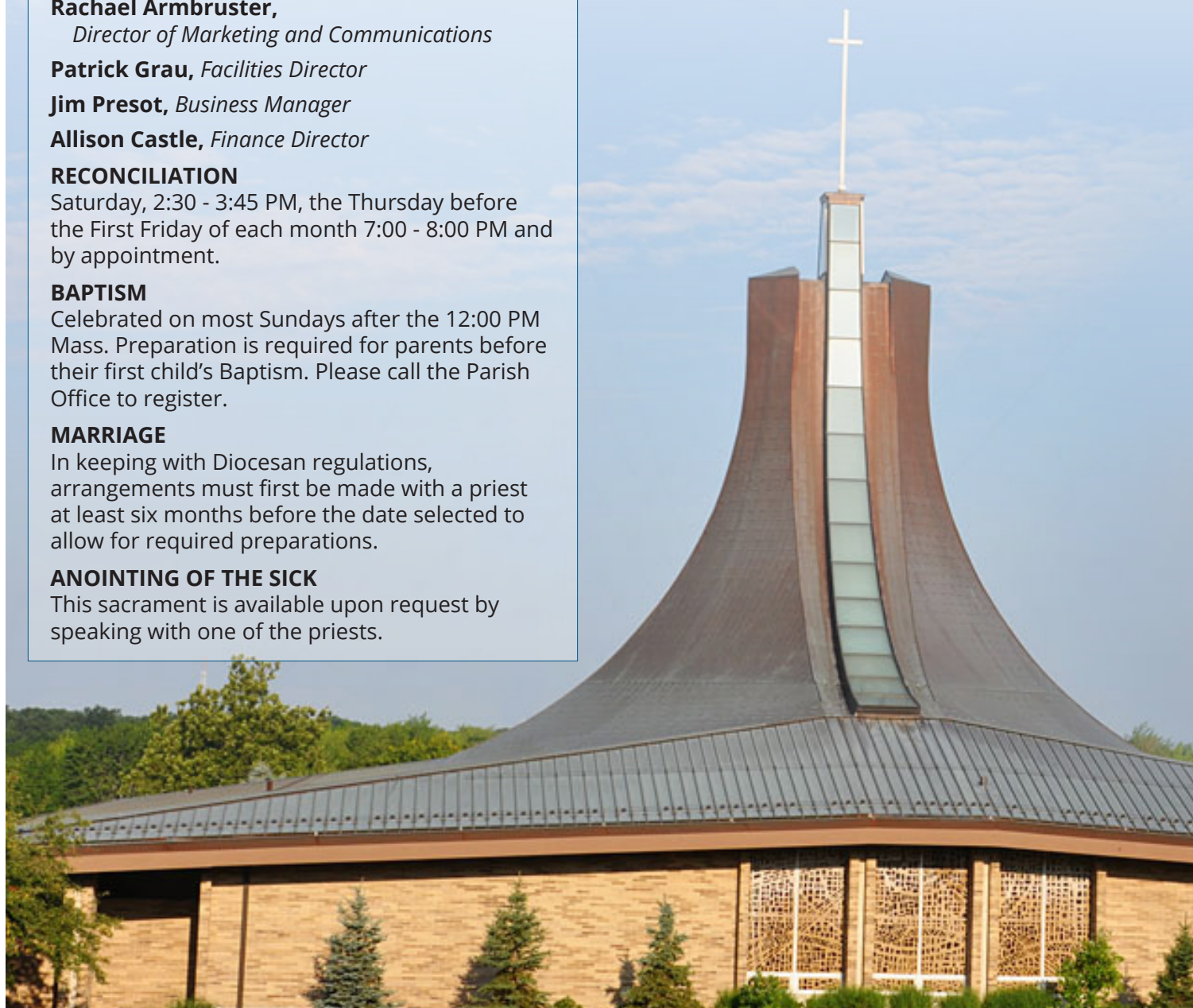

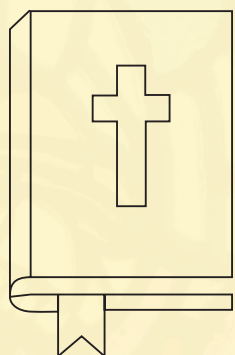

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



PARISH FEASIBILITY STUDY EXECUTIVE SUMMARY!

Over the past eight weeks, our parish engaged with CCS fundraising in the process of seeking your willingness to participate in the Diocese of Cleveland's *Called to Flourish* capital campaign. We had a great response from parishioners with nearly 400 survey responses to review. Thank you to everyone who spent time giving interviews or filled out e-survey responses. I am happy to report that the results show overwhelming support of the initiatives with 97% of the interviewees saying we should conduct a campaign. After carefully reviewing the data with CCS fundraising experts, my staff, facilities committee, and parish and finance councils, we are moving forward with a \$4 million dollar campaign implemented over the next six months. Please review the two-page feasibility study executive summary in the bulletin this weekend. Over the next several months, we will be developing a compelling case statement, recruiting campaign leaders and volunteers and begin personal visits with parishioners. This is an exciting time of growth for our parish and school as we honor our past and build the future together!

HAPPY INDEPENDENCE DAY WEEK!

In honor of the July 4th holiday, our parish offices will be closed this Friday, July 3rd, and our Independence Day Mass will be held at 9 AM on Saturday, July 4th. For freedom Christ has set us free from sin! Happy July 4th week to you and your families. The fourth of July has always been a time to celebrate the freedoms we enjoy as a nation and remember that our independence was won at great cost. Just two years ago, our nation experienced a truly historic moment where the most fundamental of all human rights, the right to life was restored to the most vulnerable among us, the unborn. Now is the time to continue the work of building a post-Roe America. It is our responsibility as disciples of Jesus to be leaders in healing wounds, repairing social divisions, and working toward a lasting peace. As Catholics who believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist – Jesus alive in our bodies – we must become agents of reconciliation in our broken world.

HAPPY SOLEMNITY OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL, APOSTLES, ON MONDAY!

This Monday, the Church celebrates the magnificent Feast Day of Saints Peter and Paul, martyrs and apostles. I see these two men as loved and forgiven sinners out of which the Catholic Church arose. Peter was a simple and cowardly fisherman who denied Jesus three times. Paul was a dangerous and arrogant Pharisee who persecuted the Early Church. Both were fragile sinners in need of repentance, but that is exactly what the Lord needed in order to reveal to us who He is and how much He loves us.

After the Ascension of Jesus, the Apostles, full of joy, yet fearful, returned to Jerusalem, remaining on lockdown in the Upper Room along with Mary and other believers, praying and waiting for the promised Holy Spirit. They would not come out of that room the same. In fact, because of the Holy Spirit, the Apostles emerged strong and decisive. That very day, Peter delivered his first speech with such conviction that some 3,000 persons were cut to the heart and converted, giving rise to the birth of the Church (Acts chapter 2). Because of this, the words of Jesus, "You are Peter and upon this rock I will build My Church. And the powers of Hell will not prevail against it" (Matthew 16:18) resonate within us and assure us of Peter's primacy among the Apostles as a "pillar" of the Church, which Jesus will always sustain.

At Pentecost Jesus began to build His Church and it continued to grow. Soon, though, trials, suffering and persecution ensued. Nonetheless, the Lord Jesus was in control. In fact, it was while persecuting the early Christians that the second "pillar" of the Church was chosen. He would have to suffer much for the Lord, but he would bring Christianity to the rest of the world. We all know what happened to Saul on the way to Damascus, how he encountered the Risen Christ. Blind and fearful, brought down to the dust, Saul, who later became Paul, experienced the most startling conversion. Like Peter, Paul went through his own conversion and had to regain his strength after experiencing his bitter weakness and inadequacy. Then, Paul emerged a most ardent and intrepid Apostle of the Lord.

In their heroic actions, Peter and Paul were able to pass on to us the ultimate paradigm shift that has the power to save the world: the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We must continue to bring it to the people of our time in the middle of our own divisions, challenges, war and civil unrest. I pray today, that through the intercession of Saints Peter and Paul, we will regain our strength after all the happenings in the world and confidently place ourselves in God's hands so we may continue to build the Catholic faith with the power of the Holy Spirit and with the same humility, dedication and enthusiasm of our forefathers. A lasting peace is only possible by embracing the forgiving love of the Cross of Jesus Christ. It is my hope that we may bravely face our own uncertainty, trials and sufferings as did Peter and Paul, with our eyes fixed on Jesus Christ, the hope of our salvation.

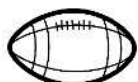

ST. COLUMBKILLE PARISH FEASIBILITY STUDY

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

PRESENTED BY CCS FUNDRAISING

CCS engaged with St. Columbkille in April 2026 to test the feasibility of a \$12.5 million campaign (with a \$4 million investment from parish reserves) to address four key investment priorities for the parish, in addition to participation in the Diocese of Cleveland’s *Called to Flourish* campaign:

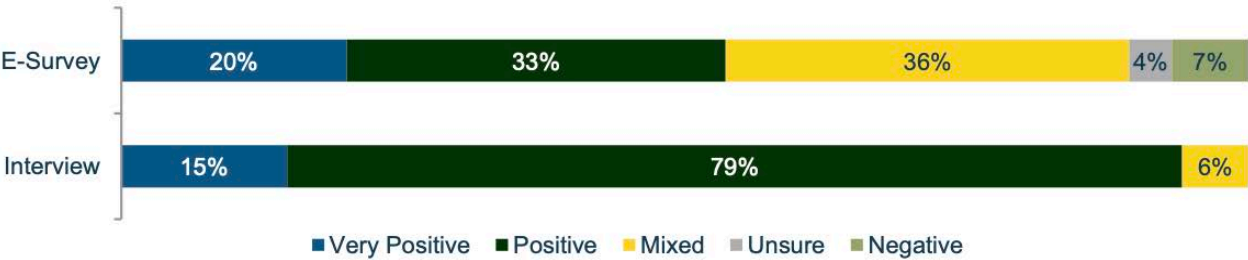
- 1. **Sacred Worship Space:** church interior beautification, entry vestibule, entry plaza, Adoration chapel, accessibility improvements
- 2. **Parish Offices & Meeting Spaces:** office renovation, Parish Hall updates, updated meeting spaces, dedicated food pantry, removal of White House
- 3. **School Enhancements & Safety:** boiler, A/C, interior repairs, covered school entrances, outdoor pavilion, accessibility improvements
- 4. **New Rectory Residence for Our Priests:** providing privacy separate from parish offices

STUDY METHODOLOGY

In CCS’s experience, successful fundraising campaigns are built upon four pillars: a compelling case for support, volunteer leaders willing to advocate for the cause, committed prospective donors willing to consider gifts, and an organized plan for fundraising. The following information outlines key findings in each of these areas.

REACTION TO THE PROPOSED CASE STATEMENT

The top five funding priorities include school renovations, new entry vestibule and elevator, new entry plaza, new rectory residence, and church interior beautification. Accessibility was a priority across the board.

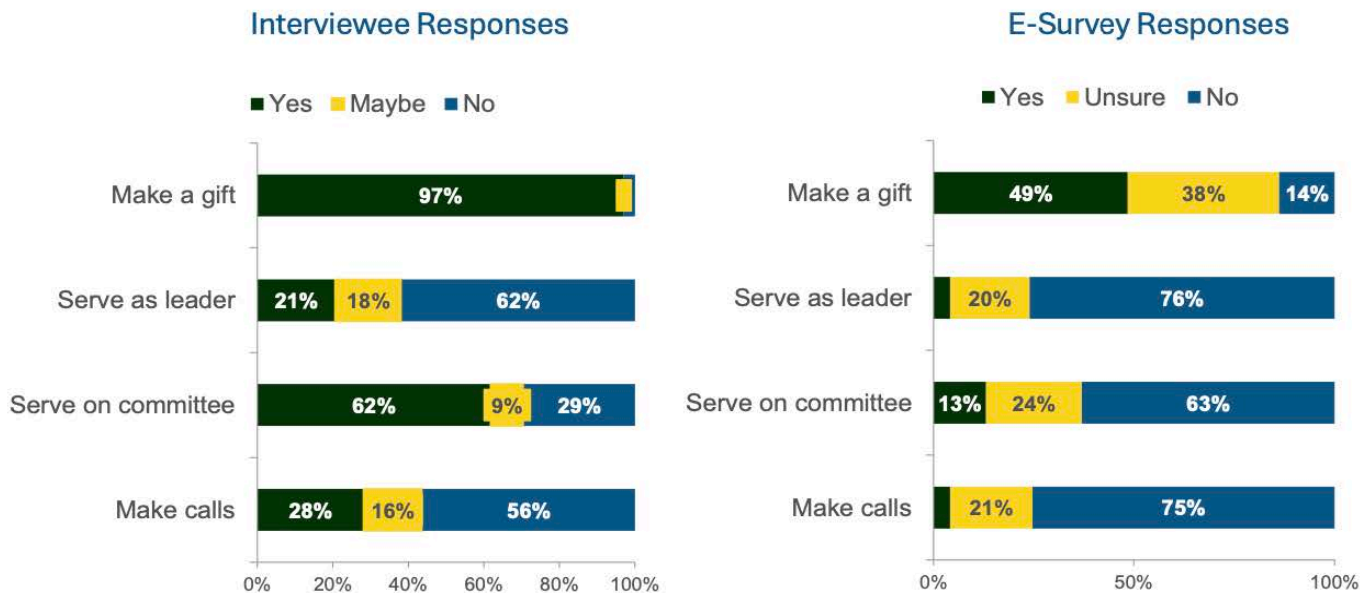
REACTION TO THE PROPOSED PLANS

3 Interview Questions; 3 Resounding Affirmatives

- 97% should conduct a campaign; +25 pts vs. CCS Sector Benchmark (72%)
- 88% now is the right time; +18 pts vs. CCS Sector Benchmark (70%)
- 79% parish is top philanthropic priority; +14 pts vs. CCS Sector Benchmark (65%)

Develop a compelling **case statement** and additional campaign materials that paint a clear picture of the needs

RECRUIT CAMPAIGN LEADERS

Recruit **campaign leadership and volunteers** who represent the parish and school.

PURSUE A PHASED APPROACH

Create **appropriate approach strategies** for parishioners in early phases as well as public phase. Prioritize personal visits, thoughtful target requests, and peer-to-peer engagement to build momentum

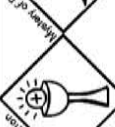
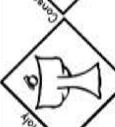
