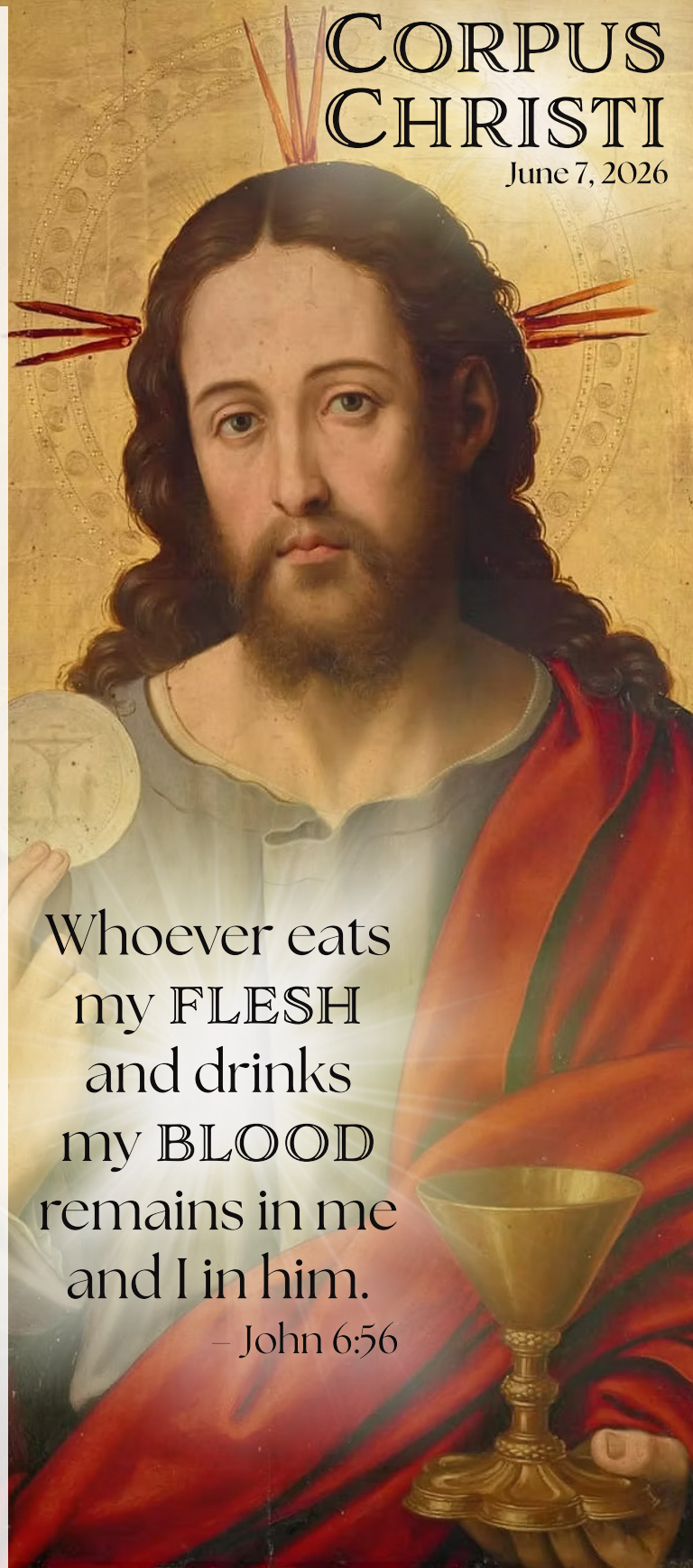

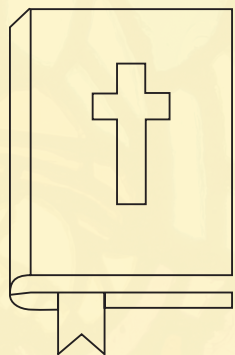

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST!

Our belief in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist is at the core of what makes us Catholic. Jesus' real presence in the Blessed Sacrament is the source and ultimate end of everything we do as a parish family. Why do we have a school? To assist young people in forming a personal relationship with Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Why do we feed the hungry and take care of the sick? To introduce them to our personal relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist.

As Catholics, we hold firm to Jesus' words in the Gospel of John chapter 6: Jesus said to the crowds: **"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."** Jesus is not fooling around when He gives His disciples this teaching and the Eucharist remains our most important connection to establishing a relationship with the Blessed Trinity. We believe that when the priest prays the words of consecration over the bread and wine, they truly and substantially become the Body and Blood of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. This is why we spend so much time adoring our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.

14-YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF OUR PERPETUAL ADORATION CHAPEL!

Fourteen years ago this weekend, our parish celebrated the opening of our Eucharistic Adoration Chapel. Our Adoration Chapel is located at the entrance of our Parish Center just before turning right into the meeting rooms. Members of our parish have spent over 90,000 hours in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament over the past fourteen years. Tremendous graces and blessings have come from these prayers, including miracles of healing. The Holy Eucharist is the source and summit of the Catholic Faith. We are so blessed at St. Columbkille to have a Eucharistic Adoration Chapel where we can adore our Lord any time of day. Right now, our chapel is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
