We have been able to provide over 800 meals to the homebound members of our parish over the past year. Stay tuned! ### **SAINT MARY MAGDALENE, PRAY FOR US!**

This Wednesday, July 22nd, the Church invites us to celebrate the Feast Day of Mary Magdalene. "Apostle of the Apostles" is the title given Mary Magdalene by St. Thomas Aquinas. Her name comes from her hometown of Magdala, a fishing village on the western shore of Lake Tiberias. St. Luke the Evangelist tells us, in Chapter 8 of his Gospel, how Jesus went from town to town announcing the Good News of the Kingdom of God, and how the Twelve Apostles were with Him together with some women who had been healed of evil spirits or infirmities and were serving them. Among these was a certain "Mary, called the Magdalene, from whom seven demons came out."

As Biblical exegesis teaches, the expression "seven demons" could indicate a serious physical or moral malady that had struck the woman and from which Jesus had freed her. But, until now, tradition has claimed that Mary Magdalene was a prostitute. This is only because in Chapter 7 of Luke's Gospel, we read of the conversion of an anonymous "known sinner in that city" who, when Jesus was a guest in the house of a notable Pharisee, bathed His feet with perfume and her tears and dried them with her hair." Without any real textual connection, Mary of Magdala was identified with that unnamed prostitute. There is a further misunderstanding: anointing with perfumed oil is a gesture that was also performed by Mary, the sister of Martha and Lazarus, on a different occasion, as reported by St. John the Evangelist. And so, in some popular traditions, Mary Magdalene has come to be identified with this Mary of Bethany, after being confused with the prostitute of Galilee.

Mary Magdalene appears in the Gospels in the most dramatic moment of Jesus' life, when she accompanies Him to Calvary and, along with other women, observes Him from afar. She is still there when Joseph of Arimathea places the body of Jesus in the sepulcher, which is closed with a stone. And on the morning of the first day of the week, she returns to the tomb, finds the stone rolled away, and runs to warn Peter and John. They in turn hurry to the empty tomb and discover that the body of the Lord is missing. The two disciples return home but Mary Magdalene remains at the tomb in tears. Her initial disbelief gradually turns to faith when she sees two angels and asks them if they know where Jesus' body has been taken. Then she sees Jesus Himself, but fails to recognize Him. She thinks He is the gardener, and when He asks why she is crying and who she is looking for, she replies: "Sir, if you have taken Him away, tell me where you have put Him and I will go and remove Him." But Jesus says her name, "Mary" – and she recognizes Him at once: "Rabbuni!", she says, which in Hebrew means "Master!" Jesus then tells her: "Do not cling to me because I have not yet ascended to the Father; but go and find the brothers and tell them I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God." So Mary Magdalene goes to the disciples and tells them she has seen the Lord and that He said these things to her. (cf. John 20).

Mary Magdalene is the first among the women following Jesus to proclaim Him as having overcome death. She is the first to announce the joyful message of Easter. But she also proved she was among those who loved Him most when she stood at the foot of the Cross on Mount Calvary together with Mary, His Mother, and the disciple, St. John. She did not deny him or run away in fear as the other disciples did, but remained close to Him every moment, up to and including the tomb. Pope Francis elevated the memory of Mary Magdalene to the status of Festivity on July 22nd, 2016 in order to stress the importance of this faithful disciple of Christ. St. Mary Magdalene, pray for us.

Never forget, the Lord Jesus is with us, always!

## PARISH NEWS



What do you believe about weakness? Perhaps you equate it with shamefulness or maybe even failure. When did weakness become such an ugly word? Today's second reading, if not understood in context, could work to reinforce this negative connotation of weakness. In this context St. Paul tells us that in our weakness we do not pray as we ought – in essence, we pray for what we want instead of for what we really need. So where does this particular weakness originate? From fear. Fear that the situation won't improve, won't turn around, won't end. However, there is something else at play here;

our own wisdom. In our own wisdom, we believe we know how this circumstance should turn out and so we pray for what we want out of our own wisdom – and this is the weakness St. Paul is pointing to that needs the intercession of the Spirit. We do not pray as we ought because we are filled with fear and fear is tunnel vision – emotionally, psychologically, and neurobiologically. We may have good reason to fear, but fear almost never produces good reason. So, we ask the Spirit to intercede for us, "with inexpressible groanings," which are the cries of our hearts in moments of overwhelm. Then God, "who searches hearts" will, in His wisdom, pierce the darkness of fear and provide what we need.

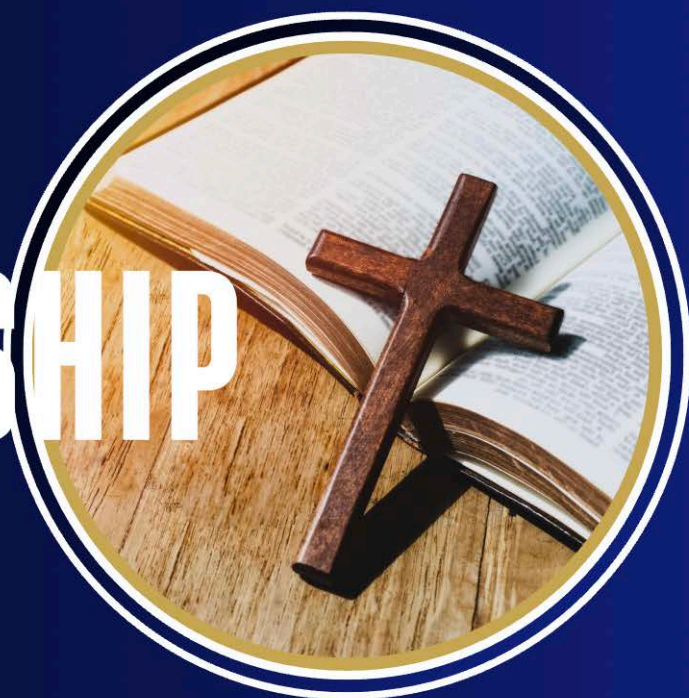

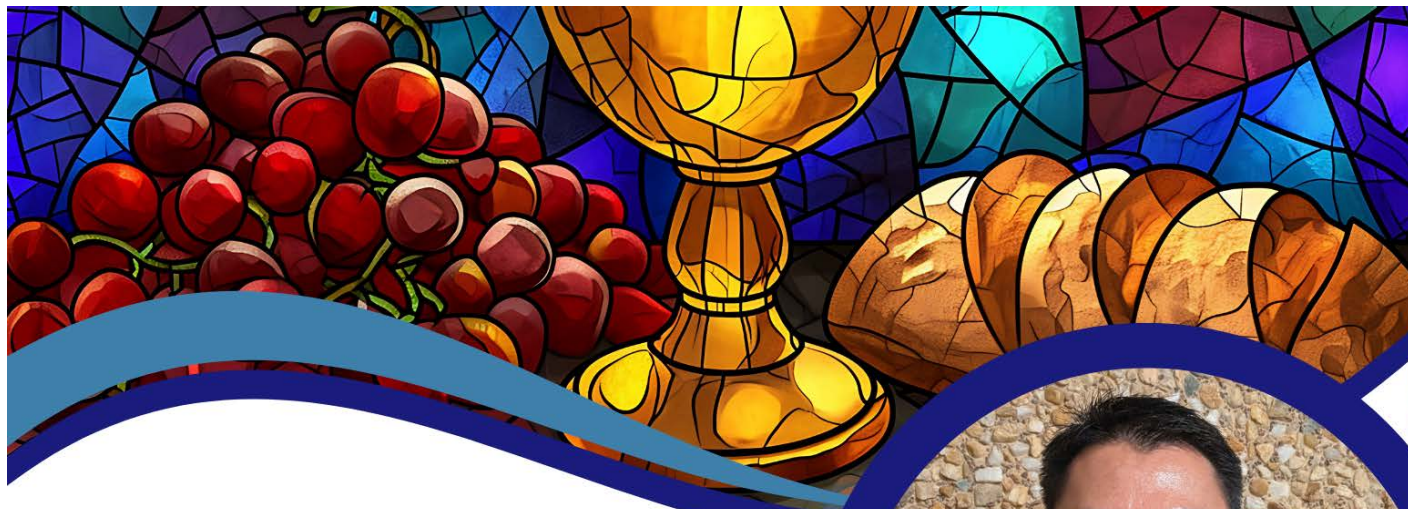

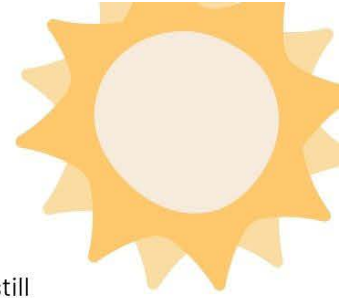
